On Prayer XI (Hebron)

As I wrote last month, there are some things about prayer that must be revisited before moving on to international and other types of intercession. Last time we said that we are not friends of God because we are intercessors, but that we are intercessors because we are friends with God.

Our friendship with God is represented in the scriptures by a famous mountain in Israel. Its name, Hebron, comes from a word that actually means to have fellowship with, join together, or be in league with. We are talking about friendship, fellowship, or communion with God (Khaw-bar, Khaw-ber, Kheb-rone). Abraham, God's interceding friend, was associated with this mountain. He is actually buried there with his wife Sarah. We can see much about friendship with God and what it produces for the intercessor by looking at the symbolism associated with this mountain – Hebron.

1: At 3040 feet above sea level, Hebron teaches us that the highlight of the Christian life and the pinnacle from which all else should flow is friendship with Almighty God. It is only from this high point, friendship and communication with God, that we can look down on life with correct perspective – God's perspective. David, the king and psalmist misunderstood about the prosperity of the wicked (Psalm 73) until he was able to see from God's point of view:

"For I was envious of the boastful, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked......Behold, these are the ungodly, who are always at ease; they increase in riches.....When I thought how to understand this, it was too painful for me."

David went on to explain what eliminated his troubled heart:

"Until I went into the sanctuary of God; then I understood their end......for indeed, those who are far from you shall perish; you have destroyed all those who desert you for harlotry. But it is good for me to draw near to God; I have put my trust in the Lord God, that I may declare all your works."

Like David, we need to get our perspective on life from God's viewpoint. One of the most important things you will ever learn is to intercede from God's perspective. Living at Hebron, the high place of friendship, makes this possible. As you spend time with God, you will have to ask him what to do less because you will learn to think like him, which will allow you to pray according to His heart and will. This agreement with God is a key element of intercession, of any kind of prayer, as we have talked about many times. It guarantees our success. Many people, as we have already discussed, spend much of their prayer time asking for their wants, never thinking about what is on God's heart. This is not true relationship. As you live at Hebron, you will increasingly care about what is on God's heart, just as He cares about what is on your heart.

2: Hebron became the home of Caleb, one of the greatest warriors of Israel. Friendship with our Father makes us powerful overcomers. Caleb, the faith-filled spy and warrior, asked God for Hebron as his inheritance. God granted his request, and the mountain of friendship became the mountain of the conquering warrior. The heart of a warrior and the tender heart of a friend are not in conflict. On the contrary, Caleb was a great warrior because of his relationship

with God. God, your Father and Friend, wants you, also, to be a conquering intercessor living at Hebron.

3: Intimacy with God – living at Hebron – will cause your intercession to defeat the giants in your life and in the lives of others. Hebron was formerly Kerjath-Arba before Caleb conquered it by killing its ruler Arba, who was the greatest of all the Anakim, or giants in Canaan (Jos 14:14-15). Caleb renamed it Hebron. Your Father wants you to be a warring intercessor, defeating every giant that comes against you.

4: The Hebron lifestyle will give you the ability to walk in great authority. David was anointed to be king over Israel and he ruled from Hebron for 7 ½ years.

Sin and our flesh, the forces of darkness and negative things we experience in the world want to rule our lives, but the Father wants <u>us</u> to rule over these things. Rom 5:17 says, "For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ." God wants to crown us, like David, with the authority to rule in ungodly situations. Intercessors rule from Hebron.

5: Finally, the mountain of friendship will also become for you a place of refuge. Hebron became one of the cities of refuge in Israel, places where those who accidentally killed somebody could run to and live without worrying about being killed out of vengeance.

As you become an intercessor, and more importantly, as you begin to operate on a more and more intimate basis with God, you will discover that this place is one of great comfort and safety in this life.

The following story, which was taken from the internet, shows how intercessors established a place of refuge for hurting children:

"Last school year, an elementary school teacher's classroom was made up of 3rd – graders, every one of whom came from a difficult situation. Some were from single-parent families, some were from dysfunctional families, some were undernourished or uncared for, some lived in abusive homes, and others had been beaten, bruised, or raped by family members. One little girl's dad had died of AIDS, and the list goes on. The teacher's heart bled for these kids.

Before the 1999-2000 school year started, she and her husband went to her classroom and prayed over each desk in the room. They prayed that God would place an angel behind each and every child throughout the coming year, to watch over them and protect them.

A month or so after the year started, she gave the kids an assignment to write about what they wanted to be when they grew up. Each was busy with his or her assignment when Andrew raised his hand. When she asked him what he needed, he asked her how to spell "mighty." After answering his question, she asked him why he needed to know. Andrew said it was because when he grew up he wanted to be a "mighty man of God." When he said this, little Mark, sitting next to him, asked, 'So, what's a mighty man of God?" The teacher, knowing she could not say anything about this herself in the classroom, told Andrew to go ahead and tell Mark what it was.

Andrew said, 'It's a man who puts on the armor of God and is a soldier for God.' After observing the conversation between Andrew

and Mark, the teacher, with a lump in her throat, had begun to walk away when Andrew motioned with his little forefinger for her to come closer. He whispered to her, asking if she believed in angels. She told him yes, she did. Then he asked her if she thought people could see angels, and she said she thought some people probably could. Andrew said that he did, and he could see an angel standing behind each kid in the room."

The classroom became a place of comfort and safety, a place of refuge for those children. God allowed this child – a mighty man of God in the making – to see the answer to the intercessor's prayers. Their intercession was born by allowing God's heart for these kids to become their hearts. These are the perfect examples of Hebron intercessors, operating out of their places of friendship with God.

God's heart is the same for us as it was for Abraham, Caleb, and David. As we become intercessors for Him and with Him, He wants us to do this from Hebron – friendship with him. This will result in fulfillment for God, fulfillment for us, and victory for many people. Intercession will become a passion, not a duty, a lifestyle, not a labor.



Almighty God Refuses Access

READER'S NOTE: There are many advantages to the body being in unity – many things we cannot do unless we have it. We continue to lose battle after battle because we have not yet attained it. But it is not just a good idea; Almighty God commands it.

Mickey McConnell has a written a book on the subject, Almighty God Refuses Access, which is presently being used as a text book. BFN has permission to print from it. It is recommended reading, as is his newly-released end-time novel Twilight Triumph. They are available from Amazon.com or from BFN.

Mickey has been a pastor, a missionary, and worked with troubled teens. He is a teacher, a speaker, an author, and a godly brother in Christ Rick

Before I give you another example, let me make a point here. Read Acts Chapter 10, and starting with verse 34, "Then Peter opened his mouth and said, 'Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: But in every nation he that fears Him, and works righteousness, is accepted with Him." If you read the whole passage, you will find That Almighty God had sent Peter to speak for him to these men. The Almighty had given Peter a vision, and an angel from the most high was also involved. Almighty God made sure, that Peter knew what he was supposed to say to these men, and that he would successfully find them and give them his message. Notice what is said there in verse 34, "God is no respecter of persons." In verse 28 we find, that Jews were forbidden to hang out with Gentiles. Almighty God went to great lengths to teach Peter not to be a respecter of persons, and then sends him to a group of Gentiles with the good news. Notice in Acts Chapter 11, and starting with verse one, there were people of the circumcision, who disputed with Peter about having gone into a house of uncircumcised men. Peter thoroughly explained the chain of events from Almighty God that had convinced him to go to this Gentile house, and preach to them. In verse 18 we learn that, at this point, they became silent and glorified Almighty God. They realized that it was Almighty God's plan to also bring salvation to the Gentiles. They could have resisted while insisting that their religion of Judaism forbade such behavior, but they would have been resisting the Holy Spirit to do so. You know what? We need to be very careful concerning what we resist, because it might be from Almighty God. The scriptures are very clear: we are to test thespirits to see if they are of Almighty God.

Now stop and think about that! We actually have an example here, of people with new

knowledge that is clearly from Almighty God, giving way to what Almighty God wants to accomplish. Oh that church denominations would give way to Almighty God! Oh that every opportunity would be seized upon, to unify the church without compromising the black and white tenets of the faith. Back in Acts 10:34, Peter spoke of his revelation, that whoever is an Almighty God fearing person and works righteousness is accepted with Him. This is a profound principle we have discovered here. Obviously, anyone who is God fearing will seek to please Almighty God. If they receive more light, they will adjust their doctrine, and their lives, to bring them into alignment with Almighty God. It says that whoever fears Almighty God and works righteousness, is accepted with Him. I really like that it does not matter what nation they are from. It does not matter what color their skin is. It does not matter if they are a man or a woman. It does not matter if they are a boy or girl. It does not matter what political party they belong to. It does not matter which denomination they are part of. Whoever fears Almighty God and works righteousness, is accepted with him! The Almighty is no respecter of persons. He is impartial. His love reaches equally to every one of us. Another passage in essence says this, "Almighty God honors those who honor Him." It is clear that he does not respect anyone based upon their denomination. So why are we in competition this way? We are supposed to be in the same ball park, cooperating with our brothers and sisters for the sake of the kingdom. It makes no sense at all. The Almighty is not impressed in the least by denominations. He has one church, it is known as "The body of Christ," or "The Bride of Christ."

There is another extremely important precept that I want to present here. Mat 5:8 says, "Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God." This is a good measuring stick for testing when people are walking in the flesh or walking in the spirit. A person that refuses to listen to sincere and legitimate questions is probably walking in the flesh. A person who gets angry when discussing doctrine, has wandered into operating in the flesh. A person who becomes impatient is probably walking in the flesh. A person who refuses to consider the idea that their denominational doctrine might need some adjustment, is walking in the flesh. A person presumptuously pushes denominational doctrine on others, is most likely walking in the flesh. I hope you are getting the idea here. When you see phenomena such as these, it does not mean that the persons engaged in such are not Christian, but you can know that they are not walking in the spirit. "The pure in heart" are striving to be pleasing to Almighty God. Walking in the flesh manifests portions of our character that have not been subjected to Christ. This is our carnal nature gaining the ascendancy at times, and we are to bring that renegade portion of ourselves under the lordship of Christ. When you see the carnal nature in action, you see something that is not "pure in heart." A person with a pure heart that loses self-control will feel badly about it, and will see the need for a humble apology.

"I've been through some major hell being saved. A man once pulled a .38 on me because I told him to stop living in adultery. My first wife left me because I was called to preach.

"God is going to fix up his church. The church has got to love and be able to work with those in other churches. The devil wants the churches divided. God wants people saved. Stop depending on the pastor to do everything. He calls us to preach, but he calls <u>you</u> to go out and bring us people to preach <u>to</u>. God does not require you to do it all, but he requires you to do something. It's time for the church to get fixed up."

"Up until Jesus died, he was only there for the children of Israel. They had to reject him and he had to die before we the gentiles could be grafted in.

"This woman could have gotten indignant, but she did not and her daughter was healed.

"There are 6 things we need to know:

1: You can't give what you don't have. John and Peter in Acts 3 gave what they had. 'Such as I

have I give to you. In the name of Jesus Christ...' We have the formula down, but we don't understand the process. When we use the name of Jesus, hell backs up a bit and says, 'does he know what he is saying? Does he really know, realize, the power?'

2: We want a drive thru window to God. Sometimes we can't handle what God has for us yet. We have to wait. Most people today don't know how to pray through. Does your prayer life have any substance?

3: We have to believe – to know – God had appointed us. We make superstars out of ministers. I am not a superstar. I am like most of you. Hell does not bow to me, but they <u>do</u> know my name.

4: It is the anointing that destroys the yokes, not us. We see this in Luke 5:17.

5: It is for <u>his</u> glory, not ours. With Jesus people saw the miracles and glorified God. If I hear more about the miracles than I do about Jesus, he is not being glorified.

6: The authority has been given to you, but you cannot walk in authority if you cannot submit to authority.

"The Lord told me 'Praise me and I will heal you.' My Dr. didn't hold out much hope for me, for the test to come back negative. She told me not to get my hopes up. The test did come back negative. The anointing!

"It's Shakin' time," Pastor Patsy Garrett started after a most astounding period of building-shaking prayer. "God will not <u>be</u> in a box. If we are not in the middle of what God is doing, we better get there. In Act 4:7-13, Peter and John had just healed a man outside the temple, and the Sanhedrin wanted to know by what power they did this thing. Peter had a mouth on him. He was bold and not ashamed of it. The Sanhedrin were getting upset; they saw that these two men had been with Jesus. When you have Jesus on the inside it shows on the outside. If people cannot tell you are a Christian by your actions, you ain't one.

We see in V₁₄₋₁₆ the Sanhedrin were looking at a man they all knew was healed. 'We cannot deny it,' they said. In V₁₉₋₃₁ we see, after a prayer for

boldness, the building was **shaken.** This was not an earthquake; it was the power of God. **Shaken!** When was the last time you (see pg 8)

called for him to be punished. 'Thou art the man,' Nathan told him. What is done in the dark will come to light. To be who God wants you to be, do like David; fall down before God and he will restore you. 'Lord, I want to laugh, have peace, be a husband, a father, but I can't until you restore me.' God will restore you, but you must be ready to be restored.

"As men, we have to learn our responsibilities. Some men shift the blame here, there, everywhere, but to themselves. We have to stop blaming the system. This Joy I have, the world didn't give it, and the world can't take it away. David said, 'Then I will teach.' People try to teach and they have not been restored. I can't tell you God is a healer if I've never been sick. I can't say he is a deliverer, if I haven't been delivered, like from Crack cocaine.

"God can restore you, your health, job, home, family. Sometimes, when you're being restored, you have to throw things away that you don't want to throw away. Let him make you the man he wants you to be."

But we are blessed with the word, II Cor 12:9, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my strength is made perfect in weakness." "In Luke 11:1 the disciples asked Jesus to show
them how to pray. I'm working and working,
and God said to just shift this over here and that
over there. Now I'm not working harder, but 3
times more effectively. How will you know the
Lord's will if you don't talk to him? Prayer,
which needs to include listening, is so important

because, if God is speaking to you, he will do so no matter what people say.

"Without faith it is impossible to please God. You ask him for something and he gives it to you. How is he going to do that if you don't trust him. God cannot be conned. You can con yourself, but not God. God cannot use a man who can't trust him. You say, 'We have a program next Friday.' Did God tell you to do that? He will send you someone to tell you that he did not say that. Without a prayer life, you can do nothing anyway. Unless God leads you and blesses it, you have not gifts.

"You are the head of the family," Dr. O'Neal said weeping, "Your children are behind you. Your wife is behind you. Some of us have children that haven't been born yet. They exist in heaven. You must pray. You are God's servants and hell must obey you. If you went to another country and they arrested you and roughed you up, you are a U.S. citizen and your country has to back you up. Righteousness means that you are in good standing with the government. In our case, according to Mat 6:33, this government is the kingdom of God. God saved you, your name is written in the book of life, you are a citizen of the kingdom of heaven. "Jesus did not preach religion; he preached the kingdom of heaven. He was not crucified because he was preaching religion. He was not crucified because of anything he did, but because of who he was.

"In Gen 1:26 God said, Let us make man in our image and let **them** (us) have dominion over the earth. God put his word above his name. Therefore, he needs those who will pray (communicate with him) in order to carry out his business on earth. He will not go against his own word.

"The forces of darkness will let you go to church, to a revival, to a conference, but not to a prayer meeting. Why? Because, if you show up there with the keys to the kingdom, their plot is ruined. When you wake up at 2 am, pray. You will get answers.

alcohol control your destiny because that is what your day is concerned with, thoughts of this substance. You are married to this substance. One of the most frustrated people in the world is one who has a dream and does not know how to make it come to pass. There is no one on this earth that was placed here to do what you were created to do. God placed in every person a purpose. In addiction you don't have God in your life. You may be doing things that are alright, but are you doing what God intended for you? In a life of addiction or drug abuse, you never discover your purpose. If you die without Christ, you end up in hell.

These reading glasses are intended for reading, but you could sharpen the ends and stab somebody in the eye, even kill them. They would not be used for their intended purpose. We are usually not made to know our purposes. God **made** you. Only he knows your purpose. Ask him.

Every human being was created to accomplish something that no one else was created to accomplish. We get so busy **going** to church instead of **being** the church, that we never usually find out. You were delivered 2000 years ago. If you find out what you were delivered from and take it, the shackles will fall off. Let go of the past so you can embrace the future. II Cor 5:17, a new creation, a new species that

never before existed. You may not **feel** like that, but it doesn't matter what you feel. Let your feelings catch up with what you know. Your spirit wants the word of God. That is what you really love to eat. We need revelation, not just knowledge.

Addiction is in the world. It is not going away. Drugs and alcohol destroy people's lives. Christ is the answer. The problem is a sin problem. Behavior tolerated is behavior celebrated. Those that cover over their sins will be defeated by them. Whatever we put up with are the things that will destroy us.

There are good addictions and habits and those that have a bad outcome. Bad habits lead to bad thinking, which lead to a bad life. Many people believe that they will always have the "disease" of addiction. They are actually taught this lie by those who believe they know. This is from a medical community that always concentrates on treatment rather than cure because treatment is far more profitable than cure.

These behaviors are learned. You can relearn. The cycle of thinking can be broken. People try to do it with willpower – their own power. You hear, 'Just say no.' So, there must be something more to it than **your** will. When something has you that is stronger than you, you need a power greater than **you** to get loose.

Christ can deliver people and keep them delivered. The problem is sin. It is a sin problem. It comes in a liquid, a leaf, powder, pills and more. These are strategies of the evil one. The forces of darkness will cheat you, but not without your assistance. Christ is the only one who can deliver anyone. The word of God has been downplayed for so long that people just don't believe in his power anymore. There is no problem that we could ever have that God does not **already** have the answer to. He doesn't have to come **up** with a solution.

Years ago I went to see a woman that was sick. She was more than poor. She had almost nothing in the way of possessions. Her house was not as big as this room. When I came in, she said, 'It's the preacher. Bring him in here. Hallelujah!' She was completely happy over nothing. She was so happy with what little she had.

We must ask <u>God</u> how to overcome the problems we face. Satan does not give up effortlessly, but he can be defeated with the word. What is the **root** of the problem? Why do I have a bad attitude? Lord, what do I need to change? If I tolerate it, I won't change it.

I can't hang with people who have not overcome alcoholism. I need to be with people who are no longer alcoholics, people who have gotten free. People's opinions don't matter, only God's opinion.

Doing What Jesus Did

There is a church in Straussbourg, France. During WWII, it was bombed and the roof fell in. Inside the church was a large marble statue of Jesus with his hands outstretched. The statue was still there after the bombing, but one of the rafters had fallen on his hands and both were broken off. The people of the church contracted a sculptor to fashion a new set of hands for the statue. The sculptor met with the church board and gave them an estimate for the repair.

There was an old man in the church. He rarely spoke. He was not one of the prominent members of the church, but he entered the room where the board was meeting after the sculptor left and addressed the church board.

The next day the board informed the sculptor that they had declined his generous offer. They informed him that **they**, the church, were the hands of Jesus.

<u>You</u> are to be the hands of Jesus, you and me. Take a second and let that sink in - the hands of Jesus. What did the hands of Jesus do?**That**is what we are to do. <u>We</u> are the body of Christ. We are his eyes as well.

In Mat 6:22-23 Jesus (Yeshua) said, "The lamp of the body is the eye: if, therefore, your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light. But if your eye is evil, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness."

As Gentiles, most of us will completely miss the primary meaning of this. What is an evil eye? Someone not knowing the Jewish background might suppose that Yeshua was talking about casting spells. In Hebrew Aramaic, however, having an 'ayin ra'ah, an "evil eye," means being stingy, while having an 'ayin tovah, a "good eye," means being generous. As with many of the things Christ said, however, there is more.

The eye: What do we see? What are our minds occupied with? We feed our bodies through our mouths, but also through our eyes (i.e. what we learn) – garbage in – garbage out. What music do we listen to? What do we watch on TV? Read? Garbage in – garbage out. We have enough garbage coming in from the world that we certainly don't need to go looking for any. We need to, as the door mouse said, "feed our heads." We need to dine on his word, watch it on TV, listen to it on the radio. We need the fellowship of other disciples of Christ (I'm not talking about that denomination).

When we realize and understand that we are the body of Christ – when we realize what that truly means, we will stand up and do what Jesus did.

I Cor 12:12-13 says, "For even as the body is one and yet has many members, and all the members are of the body, though there are

many, are one body, so also is Christ. For by one spirit we are all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free, and we were all made to drink of one spirit."

What does it mean to be part of the body of Christ?

Does it mean that we kneel somewhere and say the "sinner's prayer" and that's it?

That is a great start, but it seems that too many of us forget that it is just the smallest start. The world is filled with people who have taken that step and, either decided they need go no further, or have never been shown that it's only a start. These people are sure they will be with the Lord upon leaving the earthly body. But Heb 12:14 says, "Pursue peace with all men, and the sanctification, without which no one will see the Lord." Sanctification is being set apart for the Lord. This means the growth in Christ that we must pursue if we are to be with him. It is the growth that He will give us, but we must seek it. And, even though we must seek it, he is the one who provides it. Without this growth in Christ, the Bible says we will not see the Lord. Obviously, then, there is much more that just saying the "sinner's prayer."

What does it mean to be part of the body of Christ?

Does it mean we show up at church 2 or 3 times a week, sing songs, listen to the pastor, and talk about God? Does it mean we sing in the choir, participate in bake sales, Pastor Appreciations, and church anniversaries? These are great ways to hang out with those in the family of God, but if this is all we do, we're just hanging out. **The**

Lord did not call us just to hang out.
Why would a submarine have a screen door?
It wouldn't

Why does God need people to have Pastor Appreciations, Bake sales, and Fall Festivals and hang out?

If, in our hanging out, we are hanging out with other members of the body of Christ, wonderful.

But there is more.
