# On Prayer 49 **Watch and Prav** (Part One)

The subject of "watch and pray" occurs multiple times in the Bible. According to what I have seen, there are 31 verses I found on this subject. Studying some of the scripture will help you become an intercessor.

Prov 8:34-35 says, "Blessed is the man who listens to me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors. For whoever finds me finds life, and obtains favor from the Lord."

This scripture, speaking, of course, as Wisdom, shows the importance of a daily appointment with God. You cannot watch and pray if you don't go before the throne of God daily. If you meet God Three days out of seven, that means for four days you are on your own. Thinking you can survive with a quickie prayer on the way to work is dangerous. Too many Christians try to walk in their own strength.

In biblical times, the chief elders met to transact business at the city gates; they didn't have a courthouse. God is saying, 'I want you to meet me at the courthouse every day.' The one who does not meet God every day is a sleeper instead of a watcher.

Ps 130:5-6 says, 'I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in his word I do hope. My soul waits for the Lord more than those who watch for the morning - Yes, more than those who watch for the morning.'

The psalmist waits for the Lord more than the guard on night duty waits for the morning. That is a pretty long wait. The night guard waits for the sun with great longing, but also with a strong conviction to keep his post covered.

This is the personality type we need to have type W. The "W" stands for watching and waiting for the Lord. This is way better than secular society's discussion of types "A" versus "B." We need to go to God daily, wait to hear what he wants us to do, and do it. Watching includes daily waiting.

WHAT IS A BLOOD MOON TETRAD? A Blood Moon Tetrad is when there are four consecutive total lunar eclipses, which all fall on Jewish High Holy Days. The significance of the history of the Blood Moon Tetrads is not in the fact that they are simple eclipses, but that 4 in a row all fall on the Jewish Feast days



Above is an illustration of a blood moon tetrad, Specifically the one we just saw a couple years

ago in 2014-15. The first was on Pesach (Passover) 15 April 2014, the second on Sukkot on 8 October 2014, the third on Pesach on 4 April 2015, and the last on Sukkot 28 September 2015.



"Eddie told me there have been 14 souls saved. He is dragging in souls this week. That's what we are supposed to do. You can be a preacher. If you are saved you are a preacher. This place has come a long way. How many of us know we are persevering? Do you see the body helping each other? That's what we are doing - they call, they get a live person, not a computer.

"The truth is people need each other, whether we are saved or not. At the Tower of Babel, they could actually do anything they wanted because they were in unity, in one accord until the Lord scrambled their language. Have you seen the pyramids in Egypt? They were made by men. I'm pretty compassionate. I'm a giver, but God won't let me give to people who don't have a thankful heart, people that look for the givers and try to use them. That's why I have 10 blockers. He's got us building something in the surrounding counties. The alliance is a big part. He will use anybody and he will reward you. He said he would Supply our daily needs. Store up Eternal things. What are Eternal things? Souls, people. God is all about people. when you get to heaven and you see the people had anything to do with leading to him, you will rejoice and so will they. There may be people you led to Christ, or you showed up and did something to help prepare his bride. We are she. We are his bride.

"Satan is after the identity of people just like Dustin at Real Identity says. Being in business for 40 years, I can tell them the truth: kids need to know they can deal with it. Go tell 25 people, who will tell 25 people. Word of Mouth works. It's better than i-phones, e-mails, or space book.

"I used to have what I called the save-the-male campaign. Where are the men? I kept saying, 'Lord, where are the men in this country? We need a Few Good Men. The men need to stand up for their families. Satan breaks up the families. He's got the rest of it in the bag. We got a fire back. Load up your guns or your gifts. Everyone has a talent. There are more devils in Washington than in Winder.

"Pineapple roped in some souls. It was so hot that day. These were church folks, but they didn't look it. He was sweating for those Souls. Revelation 3:10, 'because you have kept my Commandments, I will keep you from the trial that is coming to the world to test those who live on the Earth.'

"It is coming. Prepare your family. Gather the menone in the field, one gone, one and two gone. Get your family ready. Hillary Clinton: men, do you think a woman would be a good president? I'm a woman and I know that a woman is not supposed to be the head. Women must stand down. They can't control your household. You must take control of household. This is James 1:12, 'blessed is the man who perseveres through the trials, for when he has been approved, will receive the crown of life.' street. There is a prison ministry that we also do. We send out *Armed and Dangerous* books. They are a quick study. If you want to look up lust, all you have to do is look it up in the table of contents and there are the scriptures. 'Please send us more of these,' the prisoners write.

"They picked me for the board of directors of the alliance. I don't know why. Then my daughter got involved. Jody is all about logistics. Look, He (God) is doing everything. He is uniting the body. We have to be in one accord like musicians. But we must not be prideful. We can't operate with pride."

What is the cost? It is a \$20.00 donation. If you don't have the money, there are scholarships. Besides, what is the cost to the inmates if you don't



"There are times when I did the wrong thing. He walked through that wall anyway. David has a prison ministry. It should be on all our hearts. The enemy is very busy. I know what it is like to watch you baby be placed in the back of a police car. It is a hard pill to swallow. God told us to do it, so we are gonna do it.

This alliance is unique, second to none. There is nowhere I'd rather be than right here tonight. I got saved while smoking a joint. I said, 'I can't smoke this; God is calling me.' My friend said, 'Give it to me; God ain't calling me."

"Amos 3:3, Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?" Pastor Billy Angel told those at Holy Bethel. "I can't walk with that brother because he smokes. I can't walk with her because she... Matthew says let the wheat and the tares grow together and let God sort 'em out. If we are gonna accept each other, and you do something I believe is wrong, I'm gonna tell you. You don't have to agree with your brother, but we have to get people


