On Prayer 54 **Divine Intervention** (Part Two)

When God spared Nineveh, Jonah became angry because God made him look like a false prophet. What Jonah prophesied did not come true until a couple centuries later. But God spared Nineveh at this time because they fasted and prayed. Prayer and fasting move God to change his mind.

This reminds me of the passage in Joel 2:12-14:

"Now, therefore,' says the Lord, 'turn to me with all you heart, with fasting, with weeping, and with mourning.' So rend your heart and not your garments; Return to the Lord your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and of great kindness; and he relents from doing harm. Who knows if he will turn and relent, and leave a blessing behind him?"

Why sit around feeling condemned and discouraged? God may turn, and relent, and bless vou.

Prayer causes supernatural intervention in the destiny of individuals and the history of nations. Joel 2:17 says, "Let the priests, who minister to the Lord, weep between the porch and the altar; let them say, "Spare your people, O Lord, and do not give your heritage to reproach, that the nations should rule over them. Why should they say among the peoples, 'Where is their God?""

We can pray, "Spare your people. Spare America. Spare Israel." The fact that we can pray according to scripture for God to spare nations shows that he will intervene in the events of mankind.

Luke Warm Leftovers II

I don't want to be lukewarm. Lukewarm people tend to choose what is popular over what is right when they are in conflict. They care more about what people think of what they do (like going to church and giving) than what God thinks of their hearts and lives. Jesus said in Luke 6:26, "Woe to you when men speak well of you, for that is how their fathers treated the false prophets." He said in Rev 3:1, "I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead." I don't want to be lukewarm. Lukewarm people don't really want to be cleansed of their sin; they only want to be saved from the penalty of their sin. They don't genuinely hate sin and aren't truly sorry for it. They're just sorry because God is going to punish them.

I don't want to be lukewarm. Lukewarm people hardly ever share their faith with their neighbors or friends. They don't want anyone to feel uncomfortable by talking about private issues like religion. They don't want to make people angry. A young woman I witnessed to once told me in a very angry voice, "I'm not a Christian. I'm a Baptist." The truth is she might not have known anything about Jesus, but she knew she was not where she needed to be with Christ and that she did not know him at all (Baptists usually are Christians) and it scared the daylights out of her. We all tend to manifest fear through anger. James 1:22 tells us "Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourself. Do what it says."

I don't want to be lukewarm. Lukewarm people do not live by faith; their lives are structured so that they don't have to. They don't have to trust God if something unexpected happens – they have their bank account, their life insurance, and their 401K. The truth is, their lives wouldn't look much different if they stopped believing in God. "Fool! This night your soul will be required of you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?" (Luke 12:20)

I don't want to be lukewarm. Lukewarm people may drink and swear less than average, but besides that, they aren't really any different from your typical unbeliever. They equate their partially sanitized lives with holiness, but they couldn't be more wrong. We attempt to serve leftovers to a holy God – leftover money, leftover time, leftover love. My concern in writing this is that it may only evoke fear and guilt. Personal experience has taught me that actions driven by fear and guilt are not an antidote to lukewarm, selfish, comfortable living. I hope that you realize instead that the answer is love.

I don't want to be lukewarm. I have said this, but unfortunately, I find myself falling into just that on too many occasions. I don't want to fall into lukewarmness ever. But, you see it is not just our actions that God looks at; it is also our heart. Paul said beginning in Rom 7:14, "For we know that the law is spiritual, but I am carnal, sold under sin. For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do... Now if I do what I will not to do, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me...O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? I thank God - through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin." You see, we all sin. We all fail God, fall short of his glory, but I truly hope you can see the difference.

To call someone a Christian simply because he does some Christian-like things is giving false comfort to the unsaved. But to declare someone who sins "unsaved" is to deny the reality and truth of God's grace. Grace does not help, however, what is wrong with our hearts. Grace does not cover lukewarm, complacency. If we have as much of God as we want for right now, a reasonable portion of God among all the other things in our lives, this is not covered by the grace. Those that should be the most afraid are those that are lukewarm, and know it, and don't care.

The thing is, when you're in love, you will do whatever you have to for the one you are in love with, even things you didn't know you could do. Please, read this until it sinks in. It is vital and there is absolutely **nothing** more important. Here goes: Are you willing to say to God that he can have whatever he wants? Do you believe that wholehearted commitment to him is more important than any other thing or person in your life? Do you know that nothing you ever do in this life will ever matter, unless it is about loving God and loving the people he has made? If the answer to those questions is yes, then put your actions where your mouth is. True faith means holding nothing back; it bets everything on the hope of eternity.

giver of the word. David knew he had no good heart. He said, 'Create in me a clean heart and a right spirit.'

"Mark 16:19, He sat down at the right hand of God. That is the Law. We think the law of God is a lot of rules. The difference between rules and the law is that the law has benefits. For instance, the law of gravity – you drop it, it falls down. There seems to be an exception: a 747 weighs 600,000 pounds. It will go up because of another law, the law of lift. The airplane must be going 160 mph. If it is flying and goes less than 160 mph, it will fall. It flies every time. You just have to steer it. It is the law. In the U.S, 140 million people say they know Jesus. The keys to the kingdom of heaven: these are the laws. The plane flies because it obeys the law.

Rev 12: the Eclipse (from pg 1)

Eclipse occurs in the exact same area of the sky as the Rev 12 Sign and, as millions of people look to the sky, they will be given a short glimpse of this sign as it moves into its final stages of fulfillment. The 21 August 2017 eclipse will take place in the constellation of Leo, next to Regulus, the brightest star in the constellation of Leo. Regulus is known as the King star, and a double conjunction of Jupiter, the King planet, and Regulus in 3 BC, is part of the sign or "star" that brought the Magi to Bethlehem. The shadow of this eclipse will divide the United States almost perfectly in half. This eclipse will take place exactly 33 days before the great sign of Rev 12 on Sept. 22 and 23rd. the number 33 represents promise in Biblical

numerics.

Luke 21:25 "And there will be signs in the sun, in the moon, and in the stars; and on the earth distress of nations,"

Back in 2007 I was not sure what the Book of Revelation, and the book of Joel meant regarding the sun becoming black as sack cloth, and the moon blood red or like blood. I researched the meaning. and what I found was this: they were referring to solar and lunar eclipses. I did this research years before I found out about the blood moon tetrad of 2014 and 2015. If you are interested in learning more about the blood moon tetrads, and what they reveal, please see the March 2017 edition of the Battlefield News. Last year I went back to my notes from 2007, and I was astonished at something I wrote in the notes, something I didn't even remember writing. I wrote this in my notes: "this event will be a sign of the last days". This statement was in regard to the following verses:

<u>Joel 2:30-31</u>, "And I will shew wonders in the heavens and in the earth, blood, and fire, and pillars of smoke. The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before the great and terrible day of the Lord come."

Revelation 6:12, "And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood;"

Last week I put the date of the last blood moon in the 2014 - 2015 tetrad, 27 Sep 2015, into a time duration calculator. Next I put the date of the great Revelation 12 sign, 23 Sep 2017, into the calculator. The number of days between these two dates turned up a very interesting number, there will be 726 days between these two events. Through my study of the Revelation 12 sign, this number 726 had a very important meaning to me. We are told in Revelation 12:5 this child will be caught up to Heaven, "And she brought forth a man child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her child was caught up unto God, and to his throne."

The King James, and most other English translations of the Bible translate the Greek word "Harpazo" (pron har-pad-zo) into two English words "caught up". The Greek word "Harpazo" just happens to be number 726 in the Greek dictionary of the Strong's Concordance.

Strong's G726 - harpazō

Pronunciation här-päd'-zō

The KJV translates Strong's G726 in the following manner: catch up (4x), take by force (3x), catch away (2x), pluck (2x), catch (1x), pull (1x).

Outline of Biblical Usage

1 to seize, carry off by force

2 to seize on, claim for one's self eagerly

3 to snatch out or away

The Latin translation of the Bible translates the word Harpazo as Rapturo, where we get the English word Rapture.

I want to point something out to anyone that hasn't read my two posts detailing the Revelation 12 sign, and 23 Sep 2017. Most people believe Revelation 12 is referring to Jesus, because verse 5 states this child will rule with a rod of iron. Let's take a look at what Jesus told John to write in his letter to the Church of Thyatira:

Revelation 2:26-27, "And he that overcometh, and keepeth my works unto the end, to him will I give power over the nations: And he shall rule them

with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter shall they be broken to shivers: even as I received of my Father."



Finally, I would like to share a dream I had three years ago. A perfect stranger, that knew nothing about me, asked me a question during a casual conversation. The stranger asked me this question "have you had your calling yet". I replied "no, I don't think so" Then he said this to me "you are going to have a dream, you won't understand it completely at first, but you will in time, and I want you to call me and let me know when you have this dream"

This statement took me by surprise. Never before, and not sense, had anyone said something like this to me. The strange thing about it was the fact that I didn't think he was crazy. Instead, I believed what he said to me. I actually took his name and number down, then I went home and told my wife about the encounter. That night I got on my knees and prayed about it, asking our Father to reveal the dream to me, if this was truly a Word from Him. I went to bed, the next thing I knew I was waking up from a dream at 5:40 in the morning. This dream was the most profound, and realistic dream I have ever had in my life. To say the least, I was in absolute awe of what had just happened.

In this dream I was with a group of people, it was made known to me that I didn't even know most of these people in this group. We were in what appeared to be a gigantic maze, which I believe represents this world or this age. We were desperately trying to find our way out, but this seemed impossible because there were yellow arrows on the floors and the walls pointing in all directions. We didn't know which arrows to follow. or which arrows to avoid following. We were walking as a group, and I saw an opening. I left the group and walked to this opening. I looked through the opening and realized this was not the way out, so I turned around and rejoined the group. I believe this represents the belief I had that something would happen at the end of the Blood Moon Tetrad cycle. After I rejoined the group, we continued to make our way through the maze, still not sure what direction to take. Then I heard a female voice that came from overhead. I never saw where or who this voice came from; I only heard the voice make this statement, "Look at the train." When I heard this, I looked to my right and saw a huge silver bullet train. This train was in the midst of several other, older, rundown trains. The size and beauty of this train overshadowed the other trains. I got so excited at the appearing of this train, that my spirit was

overwhelmed with absolute joy. Next, I turned to tell the others to look at the train, because in the dream, I felt like they didn't hear the voice announcing it's arrival. Before I could get all the words out of my mouth, the train was going over head. It sounded like I was standing under a trestle, with all the clanking and vibration of an actual train. This part of the dream was in high definition with surround sound, it felt real. The train was going up at an angle toward the sky. Suddenly, a huge door in the sky opened, it was more like a huge two-door gate. The train headed toward the opening, and we, the group, followed the train into the sky toward the opening.

As soon as we passed through the threshold of the door or opening, I was instantly in an immense room. I say room, but I saw no walls, only people, a lot of people. As I was looking around taking it all in, I heard a familiar song begin to play. I couldn't tell exactly what song at the time, but I knew it was a Duran Duran song. As this song played, I saw some of the people form a single-file line and exit this room with a blank look on their faces. I researched the song a couple of days later and found out the song playing was titled Hungry Like the Wolf. The reason I didn't recognize the song immediately was because the main chorus didn't play, only the beginning of the first verse leading up to the main chorus. Think about what I just said: the song Hungry Like the Wolf started playing, and people in this room left with a blank look on their faces.

Immediately after this happened, I look down and I was holding an I-pad in my hands. There was a picture of Adam and Eve on the screen, and words began to scroll across the top of the screen. Here is what they said, "Sometimes, just like Adam and Eve, people are told lies, and made to believe.' Then I woke up from the dream. I got up and pondered the dream for a while, then I laid back down. When I closed my eyes, I heard the audible voice of God say "Write it down." So I jumped up and began writing the dream down. The last thing I wrote was "believe", because once I read that word, the dream ended. I have written that word hundreds of times, but that morning I was shown something, the word believe is three words in one: "Believe Lie Eve" Eve was the first human to believe Satan's lies, and judging from how many people left this place, she was no where close to the last. God also reiterated to me what scrolled across the I-pad screen when He brought into my remembrance the verses below:

II Thessalonians 2:10-12, "and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this reason God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness."

At the time this happened to me, I believed the Rapture doctrine was false doctrine. Unless someone could give me insight, I took this as a rapture dream. Also at the time of this dream, I had not discovered the Revelation 12 sign that will appear on 23 Sep 2017, and I had just been introduced to the Blood Moon Tetrad, and had very little knowledge of it's significance. Now I understand the Blood Moon Tetrad. The 21 August 2017 eclipse, the 13 September 2015 partial eclipse, and the 23 September 2017 Great Sign, are very significant, and seem to be pointing to something very big. I will let you decide that for yourself. Don't forget what Jesus stated in Luke 21 when he was asked this question, "what will be the signs of your coming and the end of the age?" Jesus was very specific about one thing, He said there will be signs in the Sun, Moon, and Stars. These signs seem pretty clear to me, something like the earth has never witnessed before, is about to take place.

The stranger that told me I was going to have the dream, was very specific about one thing: he said I wouldn't understand the dream completely at first, but I would in time. The part of the dream that gave me the most trouble was the symbolism of the train, what did this train represent? After I began studying the Revelation 12 sign that takes place next month, I decided to go to a few Christian web sites that help interpret dreams. Again, I was in awe at what I discovered. The two interpretations that kept repeating were as follows: a train in dreams represents either the Church or the rapture. That is exactly what my study of the Revelation 12 sign was pointing to - the rapture of the Church. I even found a poem that I will end with. The other thing is how after the dream, my life would follow the dream in detail. I took wrong turns in my study, represented by the arrows. I thought the rapture could happen in September 2015, represented by the opening I went to in my dream, only to realize it was not. Now I am telling people that I don't even know to look at the Revelation 12 sign. I believe the Revelation 12 sign could very well correspond with the rapture of the Church, or some other huge event taking place on Earth during the same time. Now I will end with the poem I found while looking up the meaning of a train in dreams. The train in my dream was in the midst of other trains. keep this in mind when you read what the poem says about the train as compared to others.

There is a train coming, and will pass by.
A time appointed, for you and I.
It's sounding its whistle, will you hear?
The whistle, an alarm, telling you it's near.
Will you get on? Will you realize it's here?
The train from Heaven, suddenly manifest and dear,

Each day prior to the first session beginning, worship and praise was led by Ashley Rane Bonds. The Outpouring services were held each night at 1900 (7pm) with worship and praise also being led by Ashley Rane Bonds prior to the night service beginning. The conference was

presented by the apostle Dustin Bonds, Pastor Matt Mote, and the prophet Jordan Brice-Conway.

- -Kingdom Dynamics (Pastor Matt Mote)

Friday 11 August

- -Household, Roles (Pastor Matt Mote)
- -Household, Rules and Responsibilities (Pastor Matt Mote)
- -What is the Prophetic? (the prophet Jordan Brice-Conway)

Saturday 12 August

- -Five-Fold Ministry (the prophet Jordan Brice-Conway)
- -Strategic Ministry (the apostle Dustin Bonds) -Prophetic Worship (Part 1 and 2) (Jordan Brice-
- Conway) -Healing Ministry (Jordan Brice-Conway)

Jordan Brice-Conway taught on the various ways to hear God speak. He began his session by using the Scripture of Acts 17 to link to his other Scriptures. He stated that God is the best communicator in the world and the heavens, and impressed upon the attendees not to limit God in anything. God speaks to us through His mouth and the mouths of others. He speaks through the following:

- -Prophets and the prophetic (Old and New Testament)
- -Sinners (Old and New Testament)
- -Children (Matthew 21:16)
- -Physical and accidental acts (1 Samuel 15:27)
- -Animals such as Baalam's donkey (Numbers 22:28-30)
- -Our heart and mind (Psalm 27:1-8)

-Dreams and visions (Genesis37:1-9)

-God's Word (Acts 2:14)

Jordan stated that God speaks the language of eternity and that conviction deals with the matter of the heart. Just as with Joseph and his dreams, we may have to go through a process before our dreams come to fruition.

In Pastor Matt Mote's session, he taught about the Kingdom Of God. He utilized the Scripture in Luke 12:31-32, which states "But rather seek ye the Kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the Kingdom." He discussed the Kingdom of God, citizenship, principles, laws, callings, gifts, ministries, and offices.

He stated that the body of Christ needs to understand their position in the Kingdom of God. We are seated in heaven with Jesus to have a heavenly view with an eternal perspective. With this comes the need and mandate to know our real identity, authority, and purpose. Real identity, authority and purpose are the foundations on which we build. They are each shown, established, and confirmed in the completed work of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

He stated that the Gospels show us the progression from servants to citizens, to friends, and to children through our relationship with the love of God the Father, grace through the Son, Jesus Christ, and fellowship in the Holy Ghost.

The prophet Jordan Brice—Conway taught on the Gifts of the Holy Ghost, using I Corinthians 12:1-31 as his starting point. He stated that some men moved in the demonic, cursing Jesus and not able to say anything good about Him. He also said that there is a counterfeit power from hell, but that the supernatural power of God will always triumph over demonic power. Acts 16:16-18 reflects this knowledge. 1 Corinthians 12:4-11 tells us "There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. 5 There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. 6 There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work. 7 Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the

common good. ⁸ To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, ¹⁰ to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, ^[a] and to still another the interpretation of tongues. ^[b] ¹¹ All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he distributes them to each one, just as he determines."

- -Word of wisdom
- -Word of knowledge
- -Faith
- -Gifts of healing
- -Working of miracles
- -Prophecy
- -Discerning of spirits
- -Diverse kinds of tongues
- -Interpretation of tongues

In Pastor Matt Mote's session, he discussed Kingdom Dynamics. He high-lighted the topics on Church offices (Bishop and Deacon), Ministries (Reconciliation-sinner to Saint and Service-Saint to service), Law and Worship (Promise and an oath by God—Covenant-the blood covenant of God and Christ), the Sanctuary, the Priests, the Offerings, the Commandments, and the Citizenship. He also discussed the 12 Spiritual Principles of Relationships as follows:

- -Honesty
- -Hope
- -Faith
- -Courage
- -Integrity -Willingness
- -Humility
- -Brotherly love
- -Forgiveness
- -Perseverance
- -Spirituality

-Service

He also discussed the Boundary Laws of sewing and reaping, as well as responsibilities, power, respect, motivation, evaluation, being pro-active not reactive, envy, and activity. Pastor Matt stated that access to our Father God and our inheritance in him is declared, documented, and signed by the blood of the perfect Lamb of God, Jesus Christ.

The following day, Pastor Matt Mote taught on the Household Roles, Rules, and Responsibilities. He stated that the Word of God shows us the Biblical roles, rules, and responsibilities for spouses, parents, and children. God instituted the family and home. He stated that there are truths pertaining to the relationships.

Pastor Matt ended his session stating that it is the responsibility of parents to keep our households and family in order as God has commanded us to do in His Word.

The prophet Jordan Brice-Conway taught the last

session of this day, What is the prophetic? He stated that the Spirit of prophecy refers to the Holy Ghost, and that every Christian that has the Holy Ghost inside of them can prophesy. He also shared that if we submit and yield to the Holy Spirit, the gift of prophecy can work through us. He cited I Corinthians 14:24 "But if an unbeliever or an inquirer comes in while everyone is prophesying, they are convicted of sin and are brought under judgment by all," He relayed to us that this Scripture reflects that the spirit of prophecy brings salvation. He also cited I Corinthians 14:3, which says, "But the one who prophesies speaks to people for their strengthening, encouraging and comfort." The functions of prophecy are as follows:

Edification - Build up and strengthening

Exhortation - A calling near, encouraging, rallying together, bringing unity and going deeper in God. Comfort - An ability to comfort and console Informational - Added to you

The sessions on the last day of the Awakening 101 conference were conducted by the prophet Jordan Brice-Conway. His first session was entitled *The Five-Fold Ministry*. This session was very in-depth in explaining the qualifications and functions of the Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Pastor, and Teacher. Some of the information he presented for these five offices is as follows:

Apostle – Predates the world. A General of high military rank. Versatile on land or other places. Can walk or move in every grace. Supernatural encounters. God marks his ministry by signs and wonders. Sent by Christ. Christ validates an apostolic ministry. Establishes culture of the kingdom of God.

Prophet – Existed before the church. Ruled over kings. Under the authority of the Apostle. Lead and guide in church. Preach and teach. Able to teach someone to hear the Word of God and articulate it back to you. Every Prophet is an Intercessor. Strong zeal for holiness and purity. Loves presence of God. Inclined to supernatural activity. More aggressive. Carries the sword of the Spirit. Confronts others.

Evangelist – Preaches and sometimes teaches the Word of God. Has some or all of the gifts of the Spirit. Signs and wonders sometimes follow him/her.

Pastor – Shepherd of his/her congregation. Preaches and teaches the Word of God. Has some or all of the gifts of the Spirit. Signs and wonders sometimes follow him/her.

Teacher – Teaches the Word of God and brings revelation of it to individuals or groups. Can have some or all gifts of the Spirit.

Jordan stated that Jesus walked in every office of the five-fold ministry. He was called Rabbi, Teacher, Evangelist, Pastor, Shepherd, and Prophet. He moved in the prophetic. He was also the Apostle of Yaweh for his 12 disciples.

The apostle Dustin Bonds discussed Strategic Ministry. He stated that the word "ministry" means to minister unto. He used Matthew 20:28 as his starting point. This Scripture tells us, "just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many." He stated that Apostolic means "sent us." I Corinthians 12:28 says, "And God has placed in the church first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then miracles, then gifts of healing, of helping, of guidance, and of different kinds of tongues." Acts 13:5 also states, "When they arrived at Salamis, they proclaimed the word of God in the Jewish synagogues. John was with them as their helper." Dustin said that Luke 5:10-11 tells us, "10 and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, Simon's partners. Then Jesus said to Simon, "Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people." 11 So they pulled their boats up on shore, left everything and followed him." He stated that Strategic Ministry long-term must be planned and carefully designed. It is not established for just then, but for movement toward the future.

The last session of the conference was conducted by The prophet Jordan Brice-Conway. He presented Healing Ministry. The two parts of this ministry are a grace that comes upon you for praying for the sick and afflicted, and the gifts of healing. James 5:13-20 states, "13 Is anyone among you in trouble? Let them pray. Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. ¹⁵And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. ¹⁶Therefore confess your sins to each other and

pray for each other so that you may be healed. The fervent prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. ¹⁷ Elijah was a human being, even as we are. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. ¹⁸ Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops. ¹⁹ My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back, remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins." Jordan stated that there are two purposes for healing, one being for the saints, and the other for the world of evangelism. It is every believer's right to be healed. Sickness is illegal in the children of God. Isaiah 53:5 assures us, "But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and by his wounds we are healed." Christ was punished for us. He knew no sin, but He took our punishment. Healing is a part of the salvation package. God's Word heals. All healings are not spontaneous or instant. Some are progressive and slow. Unrepentant sin and unforgiveness can stop healing. Some diseases are demonic and happen because a door to the enemy has been opened. The prophet asked if anyone needed prayer or healing. He asked them to come up to the front and asked for volunteers in the class to pray for them under his direction. This session closed the three-day conference. It was a great opportunity to learn, to practice, and to grow in knowledge of God and His Word.






