On Prayer 55 **Divine Intervention** (Part Three)

"Gather yourselves together, yes, gather together, oh undesirable nation, before the decree is issued, before the day passes like chaff, before the Lord's fierce anger comes upon you, before the day of the Lord's anger comes upon you! Seek the Lord all you meek of the earth, who have upheld His justice. Seek righteousness, seek humility. It may be that you will be hidden in the day of the Lord's anger." This is taken from Zeph 2:1-3, and it exhorts us to seek God and humble ourselves in order to escape his judgment.

Notice that the prayer must come before the decree: 1) before the decree is issued; 2) before the day passes like chaff; 3) before the Lord's fierce anger comes upon us; 4) before the day of the Lord's anger.

In the midst of judgment, we can find "pockets of mercy." When I first considered this concept I wondered if it was scriptural. Then, during an appointment with God, I came to the passage in Zephaniah quoted above. The Lord revealed that we can be hidden in the day of his anger. There is a hiding place in the midst of the anger of God - a pocket of mercy. Everything is not predestined, inevitable, and hopeless.

Maybe you will find a pocket of mercy. You can pray for the Lot in your life in today's S'dom. You can pray for you son who is overseas in the Armed Forces or your friend captured on an airplane by terrorist. You can say, "Maybe nobody else will get out, but I'm going to trust God and send his angels into the situation."

At the time that I found this passage, many American passengers were being held hostage on an airplane in Beirut. It appeared that they all would be killed, so I specifically prayed for god to send his angels. I felt faint while I prayed, as though I was in God's will doing spiritual battle. Now the matter is fully resolved. Some years ago, after the fact, I spoke to John Testrake, the captain of the TWA plane that was held. He confirmed that prayer definitely caused the release of the hostages. This miracle was a direct answer to intercession. These people were placed into a "pocket of mercy" as a direct result of prayer.

I do not believe that anything is inevitable or impossible. I believe that the Lord provides pockets of mercy in the midst of judgment, whether that judgment is God's or Satan's.

Mal 3:17 tells us of a separation to come: "The y shall be mine,' says the Lord of Hosts, 'On the day that I make them my jewels. And I will spare them as a man spares his own son who serves him.

God is going to spare a certain group of people. Yeshua tells us in Luke 21:36 to "pray always that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things that will come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man." You can be among those who escape. When judgment falls, God can say to you, "You are just like the diamond in my ring. You are my jewel. I am going to spare you as a father spares

Ezekiel 37:16, "Moreover, thou son of man, take thee one stick, and write upon it, For Judah, and for the children of Israel his companions: then take another stick, and write upon it, for Joseph, the stick of Ephraim and for all the house of Israel his companions."

All agree that the above is an end-time vision. Simply stated, Ephraim and the ten northern tribes are one stick, while Judah (the Jews) is the other. As we look about us now, something wonderful is happening to both the Jews and the

Isaiah 11:13, "The envy also of Ephraim shall depart, and the adversaries of Judah shall be cut off: Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not vex Ephraim."

Before the end, the Lord will take the stick of Ephraim, now in the real Church, and unite it with the stick of Judah and we will be one stick in God's hand.

Ezekiel 37:19, "Say unto them, Thus saith the Lord God; Behold, I will take the stick of Joseph, which is in the hand of Ephraim, and the tribes of Israel his fellows, and will put them with him, even with the stick of Judah, and make them one stick, and they shall be one in mine hand."

It appears that God plans to make one stick (one people) of Israel and Judah again. He is going to heal the division between them and draw them together. Within this generation, the Christians will be united with the Jewish people, and we will be one people again. The Israel of God. Are we up to the task ahead? Of course not, but now that our hearts can be opened to who Ephraim and Judah are, we can just begin to see what our end-time roles will be:

Prophecy from Esther

Boy we are going to get you thinking today, because you are going to see something that absolutely shows you that the Bible is true. You know that there are many things in the Bible that we can just see on the top. But then you dig down deeper, you can see a lot of marvelous things. One of those things you are going to see today. We are looking at Iran. Jesus said watch the nations. Iran has such a long Bible history and a prophetic future. So now Iran became a part of the great Persian Empire. In fact, Shushan the palace that was the capital of the Persian Empire is in the book of Esther, chapter 1 verse 2.

Esth 1:1-4, "Now it came to pass in the days of Ahasuerus, (this is Ahasuerus which reigned, from India even unto Ethiopia, over a hundred and seven and twenty provinces:) that in those days, when the king. Ahasuerus sat on the throne of his kingdom. which was in Shushan the palace, In the third year of his reign, he made a feast unto all his princes and his servants; the power of Persia and Media, the nobles and princes of the provinces, being before him: when he shewed the riches of his glorious kingdom and the honour of his excellent majesty many days, even an hundred and fourscore days."

So for six months he's throwing a big feast in the capital. From all over the Persian Empire the princes of the provinces have come up to the castle. The Persian king made a feast that lasted six months, and at the end of it he had a small feast that lasted seven days. They drank out of gold vessels and all kinds of things. At the end of that feast he ordered his wife Vashti to come forward and show her beauty. They were all drunk and she refused to go before them. Thus, he ordered her banished and sent her out of the kingdom resulting in, no more queen. Now he was going to look for a new Queen throughout all the vast Persian Empire. Seeking to find the most beautiful woman, he found a young maiden whose secular Hebrew name was Hadassah. Her sacred Hebrew name was Dosser. She had been brought up by her cousin Mordecai, and she became the queen of Persia. She was a beautiful woman. God wanted to use her. He needed a woman, and he needed her to be beautiful. So he equipped her.

So in one of the most fascinating accounts in the Bible is the saving of Israel, God used this little Hebrew girl. There was a man named Haman, and he was the Hitler of the day. He stood in prominence in the Empire. He was right next to the King. He was a descendent of Haggi. Do you remember Saul, who God told to kill all of the Hagrites, and he did not kill the King. There would have never have been a Haman if Saul had obeyed God. So Haman rolled through the streets and he asked that every body bow to him. He was such a proud man. One man who sat in the Kings gate was Mordecai the Jew, and he would not bow to somebody else. Haman was furious. He asked who that man was and why he would not bow. They told him that it was Mordecai, and that he was a Jew. So Haman said that I will destroy all the Jews. He offered to pay for it out of his own pocket. Through that vast Persian Empire he wanted to kill every Jew. He got carried away when he thought more highly of himself then he ought.

Mordecai learned of this plot, and he urged Esther to go before the king. Now at the time she was living in the Kings harem for the women. She said no. The King has not summoned me for 30 days. If you went before the king un-summoned, it meant death unless the king held out the golden scepter. So she was reluctant to go and everybody knows this statement of Mordecai. Esth 4:13-14. Mordecai was acting as a liaison between the house of the women and himself. "Then Mordecai commanded to answer Esther, Think not with thyself that thou shalt escape in the king's house, more than all the Jews. For if thou altogether holdest thy peace at this time, then shall there enlargement and deliverance arise to the Jews from another place; but thou and thy father's house shall be destroyed: and who knoweth whether thou art come to the kingdom for such a time as this?"

We all think about that in our own lives. That is a

favorite quote. Esther, who knows, maybe you were in that place for such a time as this, and she was. We all think that about ourselves. I believe, and I want to think that you believe that we have come to the kingdom for such a time as this, to do God's will. Now I am going to read to you Esther 5:1. It says this differently in the King James. In the King James it says that Esther "put on her royal apparel" Her, and apparel, are in italics. That means it is not there. So the King James itself says that Esther put on Royal. But look at how the Jews who speak Hebrew translate that. This is in the arch scrolls.

Esth 5:1, "Now it came to pass on the third day of the fast and of Passover, Esther donned Royal and stood in the inner court of the king's palace facing the king's house while the king was sitting on his throne in the throne room."

Now here is what the Talmud says, now this is one of those comments that you are going to get at the bottom of the Scriptures. The word royalty refers not to clothing but to spiritual royalty. Esther put on the Holy Spirit. She was close with the wholly prophetic spirit. So Esther donned the Holy Spirit. She put on the Holy Spirit and she went before the king. Of course he stretched out his scepter to her, and she was able to go in.

Now remember Haman had a plan to kill all the Jews. He passed lots, the King James says, to come up with the date to do this on. You know he is superstitious and you have to get the right date. Those lots, the word for them is pur, p-u-r. So, plural is going to be purim, p-u-r-i-m. So he cast lots, called purim to come up with the day to kill all the Jews in all the land. He was so full of hate for Mordecai that he built a big gallows to hang him on. Now Esther learned of the plot, Mordecai learned of the plot, and God gave Esther a plot. She planed a big feast and she invited Haman. It is so interesting, you will enjoy going into the book of Esther and reading how she tricked him, and how he ended up. He had plotted against the King really. Now he ended up revealed, and on the exact day that he had picked out that he was going to hang Mordecai and kill every Jew in the land. He had people out there throughout that vast Persian Empire to kill every Jew on this certain day. He picked it because it was an auspicious day. On that day, guess what happened. They got killed and they got hang because it was revealed to the King all their skullduggery.

Now, let us look at of Esth 9:1. "Now in the twelfth month, that is, the month Adar, on the thirteenth day of the same, when the king's commandment and his decree drew near to be put in execution, in the day that the enemies of the Jews hoped to have power over them, (though it was turned to the contrary, that the Jews had rule over them that hated them):'

So, the Jews in verse five, smote all of their enemies, the king gave them the right to do so. So all of those who were going to kill the Jews, Jews you get the right to kill them. This is Esth 9:5.

Esth 9:5, "Thus the Jews smote all their enemies with the stroke of the sword, and slaughter, and destruction, and did what they would unto those that hated them.

Now it tells how many they killed. Listen and attentively.

Esth 9:6, "And in Shushan the palace the Jews slew and destroyed five hundred men."

And they are going to list some names here. The names that they are listing are the ten sons of Haman, and so it lists them.

Esth 9:7-11, "And Parshandatha, and Dalphon, and Aspatha, And Poratha, and Adalia, and Aridatha, And Parmashta, and Arisai, and Aridai, and Vajezatha, the ten sons of Haman the son of Hammedatha, the enemy of the Jews, slew they; but on the spoil laid they not their hand."

were slain in Shushan the palace was brought before the king.

So they killed the 10 sons of Haman and they named them one by one, and they went to the King and they said, "this is who died." Then the king went to Esther and Said to her:

Esth 9:12, "And the king said unto Esther the queen, The Jews have slain and destroyed five hundred men in Shushan the palace, and the ten sons of Haman;" Did you get that? He said and here is who they've killed, they've killed 500 men right here in the palace and they've killed the 10 sons of Haman.

"What have they done in the rest of the king's provinces?" Here he is saying that throughout all the provinces there's no telling how many they have killed.

12 c, "Now what is thy petition? and it shall be granted thee: or what is thy request further? and it shall be done. Now get this in your mind: the king went to his beautiful wife, Esther, and he said they had killed 500 in the palace. They had hung the 10 sons of Haman. There is no telling how many they had killed out there in the provinces. Now what is your further request? Just tell me and I will do it. Now look at what Esther's further request is:

Esth 9:13, "Then said Esther, If it please the king, let it be granted to the Jews which are in Shushan to do to morrow also according unto this day's decree, and let Haman's ten sons be hanged upon the gallows."

Now he told her the 10 sons of Haman have been killed now what more do you want? Then she said, let the Jews do tomorrow what we have done today. And that the 10 sons of Haman be hanged. Well, they have already been hanged. What further do you want? Hang them in the future.

You see here, this is my green Bible. This is just the Tanakh, the Hebrew Bible, and I am going to show you a picture of one page out of that Bible. Now the Jews, the scribes, they really do not go so much by the printed Bible, although they do print their Bibles. What they really go by is those Torah scrolls that they keep at the front and the profits that they keep up in the area at the front. Those are done by scribes, and those scribes have to carefully write down each Hebrew letter from an older copy. Every one of those Hebrew letters is a number. They come to the end of a line, they have a title and they have to put that number in and see that it mathematically matches. When God gave them the responsibility of keeping his word they kept it. Those scribes are very watchful. They have to do it exactly like it is done in the copy. Now here is a page out of the green Bible

This green Bible has it exactly like the Hebrews did it. As you see here, I want to tell you something about Hebrew letters. Hebrew letters are square and they take up a certain space on the line. Look here for instance. You can see here these all take about the same space. Each one of those is in individual letter. Yet they take about the same space on the line. These are the list of Haman's 10 sons that were hanged. These are their names. Over here on what you see on the left side it says and, then it gives their names. Now, those scribes that had been doing this for years and years, and they had to copy

it exactly the right way, and Hebrew letters have to take up the right space on the page. There were some little letters. Some little letters that were not as large as the other letters. They had to write them down with their pen. They had to make them smaller. For instance, here at the top there is a siyn (pron seen). It looks like a tooth. That is in fact what it means, tooth.

So you see that letter here at the top, on the top row. But then we went down that row and we circle for you and put a red arrow, a little siyn. That little siyn is not as big as the other one. There are some other letters that are smaller. And we circle them for you. Scribes ever since the time of Esther have had to make those little letters smaller. They did not know why. Down here there is a little sheen, little I. They do not know what this means until it happens. So then, you have all heard of the Bible code, Dr. Eliyahu Rips is his name. I have this article that I got years and years ago, voice behind the word. It tells how the computer is used to trace Bible's divine source. Now you know that through repetition, counting certain letters, it has shown some secrets. Here is a secret. They finally found out what these letters mean. Actually they found that out some time ago.

She said I want the 10 sons of Haman, in the future, to be killed. You have heard of after World War II the Nuremberg trials. In the Nuremberg trials there were 11 Nazi criminals that were to be executed. But one of them took a cyanide tablet and killed himself. So 10 were left. When those 10 that were left were hanged, it was October 16, 1946. These little letters in the Hebrew dating system they spell out October 1946. Of course it is not going to be October, is going to be whatever their name of the month is. So year after year she said let those be killed in the future, and right there where their names are in the Bible, just exactly like this, it gives the date in these little letters, when the 10 sons of Haman are going to be hanged in the future. It was October of 1946 that they were hanged after the Nuremberg trials. So those 10 are considered to be the 10 sons of Haman in the time of Hitler, and the very dates.

Another strange thing that happened. When one of them went to the gallows, his name was Julius striker, he shouted out, "Purim." Purim is the day that years ago Haman was going to kill all of the Jews, but the Jews ended up killing Haman. Then the king said to Esther, what do you want in the future. Then Esther said that the 10 sons of Haman will be killed as they were today. In 1946 those 10 sons of Haman were killed, and the date was spelled out in the original Hebrew of the Bible. Even he thought that he was associated with Purim. That just tells you that the Bible is absolutely true. It has a divine source - the Lord. It is really something to know. The Bible in all of its depths, right on its surface are great truths, and we will find out lots more of these in the future. Esther had the exact date in the future, and she knew to ask for it. Remember, she put on the Holy Spirit. And the Holy Spirit told her, when she asked him what more do you want she asked for the 10 sons of Haman to be killed in the future. God, who sits on the hub of eternity, and looks down all the spokes of time, knew when those 10 sons were going to be hanged, and he put the date right in the Bible here for men to see. The Bible is the divine source. It is the word of God. Holy men of old wrote as they were moved by the Holy Spirit.

Unity is so important because God's plan is to unite everything in Christ, a reflection of the very nature of God. The new birth is the basis of our unity in Christ. A body cannot be in disunity with itself. The secret of unity is in how we view ourselves.

Who Jesus says I am is who I am. How can we view others? Phil 2:3, selfish ambition is characteristic of unbelievers, not Christians. I Cor 3:3, 'For you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and division among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men?' Eph 4:2, a humble man sees his faults in the light of Christ. He sees his own heart and the depravity. We are to see one another in the light of the cross."



Kareem Handfield of Kareem4Christ and his powerful & poignant testimony

"I grew up in the Nation of Islam. I needed a loving church to show me the way. I tried many things, but only Jesus filled that spot. My mom hooked up with the Nation of Islam n Chicago. We moved to Florida and things went down hill from there. My mom got into drugs and my step dad was a dealer. She is saved now. As a teen, I wanted to commit suicide, but I went to church and asked Jesus to save me and he did. He is my Lord. If you want to see a Muslim saved, you have to show him the love of Christ. After I was saved, I stopped rapping for about a year, but then I started writing Rap only for the Lord."



Pastor Joyce Heard of Athens Unity Fellowship "In Ezekiel, God said, 'Can these bones live?' He told Ezekiel he just wanted him to prophesy. I prophesy there will be unity in the body of Christ. The lack of unity is the devil's scheme to destroy the church. If the devil keeps us fighting against each other, we are useless. We fall right into his scheme. If you are fighting me, the devil is out running free. The Devil is a liar; we will have unity. Your church will never move forward without unity.

"Over the years the body of Christ has not held hands very well. In 1865, the *Baltimore American* reported that the church was the 'fastest growing religious group in America, with 2.5 million Christians standing together.' At present, people don't want to go to church. About 1.5 million people claim to attend church regularly. Why? I believe it is because, over the years, the church had not maintained unity.

"Unity is U-N-I-T-Y, U N I Totally Yoked. John 17! I have five fingers, but only one hand. The five fingers can do much for the kingdom of God. The body splits over issues like worship style, communion style, the kitchen in the church building, whether to say 'Holy Spirit' or 'Holy Ghost,' When the division stop? The lack of unity is destroying the church. We must have unity for the Holy Ghost to come in so we can do the work.

"Eph 4:1-6, It is not about unity at Christ the King, or Athens Unity Fellowship, or Living Hope, but unity of the Spirit. How do we unify? Unity means oneness, of the same mind. It is not uniformity, but unity. We don't have to be **like** each other to be together.

"We are not even trusting the body of Christ. I have been going to an all-white church, but I am Pentecostal and emotional, but these folks do not even say amen. How can I visit there? I must come away from me. I must come away from my intellectualism and be filled with the Holy Spirit. How can I advance the Kingdom of God in this church? God has used me there. Unity is the will of God. I Cor 1:10, 'I plead with you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all speak the same thing, and there be no divisions among you.'

"We can't be in unity without the Holy Ghost. It's God's agenda; not mine. We are not supposed to be the Lone Ranger, doing our own thing.

"Work for unity, people; don't just be okay with it. There are seven keys: First, exemplify the righteousness and holiness of God. Walk in the Spirit and you will not be able to walk in the flesh. Second, walk in humility. Thirdly, be patient with one another. The fourth key is build one another up. The fifth key is live peacefully with one another. Sixth, submit to authority, and seventh, we must be connected or we can never fulfill the word of God."



Pastor Parker James of Hill Chapel Missionary Baptist Church

"There is an application that is critical to see the manifestation in the kingdom on earth as it is in heaven, Rom 14:1-15. I have been thinking much lately on this passage because I am from an all-white Presbyterian background, but I am now at a traditionally all-black Missionary Baptist church – Hill Chapel Missionary Baptist. When I came, the pastor asked me if I had a home church. I told I had been the pastor for 7 years at University Church. He said, 'But do you have a home church?' He was reminding me that I too needed pastoral care and inviting me. I told him we were looking for a place to fellowship while we get ready to open a new church. He said, 'Welcome home.'

"Paul was working toward this application through the entire letter. You claim to know Christ, yet you don't eat the same as your brother and you talk bad about him for it. He is one that Christ died for. Paul kept going to both Jews and Gentiles. He would talk to the Jews and say, 'oh by the way, I was also sent to the Goyim. They listened about Jesus before that, but at this point, they were ready to kill Paul. Jesus touched on something in Nazareth. There were many widows, but God helped the Goy widow. There were many lepers, but God only healed Naaman the Goy.

"Not only are we saved, but now we all belong to each other. God is building a cross-cultural kingdom manifested in love.

"The pastor told me, "We are not about Hill Chapel; we are about the kingdom of God. I have a new spiritual father in Pastor Benjamin Lay. Jesus said anyone who does the will of my father is my father, my mother, my brother and sister. To find unity, we must be able to say no to the culture of the world and say yes to that of the church. These are not easy things to apply – easy to say, not easy to live. We have to find ways to not have monocultural churches but cross-cultural churches. Thank you Father that you have forged unity despite us."

"The Battlefield News tells people about unity when they are not in Church," Jody Bennett told the people at Smith Memorial AME Zion church. "I never heard anything about unity in my whole life in church. Then I met Herman and Rick and they showed me the scriptures. The Battlefield News goes where we cannot go to **show** unity. 

The Greek word translated rule in this verse means "to umpire." The apostle Paul says that we should let the peace of Christ be the umpire in our lives. An umpire keeps the peace. He makes sure the game is played in a smooth and orderly fashion. God wants to give us an internal umpire who will keep us at peace even when everything seems chaotic.

everything seems chaotic. Only as we submit to Christ's control and authority can we experience spiritual peace. We may think all we need to do is to get away, but that is not true. We can't run away to get peace. It won't come from divorcing our spouse, giving our kids up for adoption, changing jobs, or living as a hermit on the backside of nowhere. Only when we submit our internal world to the lordship of Christ will we experience peace.

If we really want God's peace, we should ask for it. A psychiatrist was quoted in the newspaper as saying that he could not improve upon the apostle Paul's prescription for human worry. Paul wrote, "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus" (Phil. 4:6-7). Notice the order: first prayer and then peace. A cause-and-effect relationship exists in this prescription. Prayer is the cause; peace is the effect.

If you and I are not praying, we're likely to be worrying. And worry is such a useless emotion and activity. Worry is the opposite of peace; they cannot coexist. Worry, like a pressure cooker, builds up our internal pressure with negative emotions and concerns. Prayer, on the other hand, functions like a safety valve. When life's stresses become too great and we feel like we are about to explode, prayer releases the stress and rustration. Everyone needs an unconditional listener to unload on and a fair umpire to call the game. In God we have the perfect embodiment of both roles. We can dump on him and know that he will not get stressed out by what we tell him. We can be confident that he will bring order and calm to our daily lives.
