On Prayer 71 Intervention by Angels (Part Three)

The third concept is that **angels are unemployed**. They are waiting to be called into action. In Emporia, Kansas, a sign in a church says, "Unemployed angels; please pray." The angels are waiting for us to pray. Much more is going on in the heavenly realm than we realize.

For example, in the garden of Gethsemane, Yeshua said, "Put your sword back in its place... ... Do you think that I could not call on my Father and he will provide me with more than 12 legions of angels?" (Mat 26:52-53).

In the time of Yeshua, each Roman legion contained over 6000 men. Twelve legions would, therefore, be well over 72,000 angels. He could've called them to prevent his crucifixion. Jesus died for one reason: he chose to. He loves you.

Between the Old Testament and the New Testament, there are almost 600 passages about angels. We will now consider seven of those passages.

Hebl:14 is a pivotal example: "Aren't all angels ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?"

Angels are servants to the body of Christ. Think about that for a moment. They are to serve <u>us.</u> The Greek word here for "minister" is **diakonia.** It is the same word used in other places in the New Testament to mean "deacon" or "servant." Angels are deacons that are there to serve you and me.

This verse says that <u>all</u> angels are ministering spirits. I believe that there are trillions of angels – 'innumerable angels" – existing to serve us.

Many people do not like to think of angels as "spirits," lest they confuse them with the Holy Spirit or Ruakh Hakodesh. Since angels are created beings, they are on a lesser level than the Holy Spirit. They are referred to as spirits because they do not always exist in a bodily form. Do not stumble at the phrase "ministering spirits." Instead, meditate on the fact that there are trillions of angels waiting to attend to your prayers.

Notice the future tense: "Those who will inherit salvation." I want to emphasize this. Each one of the innumerable angels are ministers to come to the assistance and aid of every Christian. Angels are the servants of the heirs of salvation.

We do a lot of talking about binding demons, but what do we loose? We loose angels. We loose angelic help.

I had a vision during a worship service. While looking at a family that was having marital problems, I saw an angel of God wrapping the husband and wife up in his wing – like someone would roll a cigarette. He rolled them together so tightly that nothing else could get into their relationship and they could have no affections for anyone else. Then I saw the angel take his other wing and hold off demonic principalities, powers, and forces.

I stepped to the microphone and began to prophesy the vision. The family did not go through a divorce! Then I began to pray in this manner for marriages. I prayed for eight marriages in this way. In every instance these marriages were revitalized.

I have seen miracle after miracle when angels are loosed and intervene in people's lives. Remember, since angels are not independently sovereign, they will only do God's will and enforce his purposes. But we can pray and ask God to send an angel to intervene.

Do you know someone who is backslidden? Pray specifically that God will put an angel's wing between that person and his sin, depression, or discouragement. Prayer puts angels in action to intervene in people's lives – at home, in church, on the job, and in school.

Early on a Saturday morning in 2018 I was on my knees before the Lord. What seemed to continually come out of my mouth was "Lord I know I'm not worthy but ..." Then I would make a request for my children, for revival, for our nation, for my family or whatever was coming to my spirit at that moment. As I continued to pray, the focus of my prayer became the Holy Spirit. "Lord, I desire your Spirit!" "Lord you said to ask for your Holy Spirit and I'm asking for your Holy Spirit!" After I had poured out my heart and quietly waited, I heard this: "A son does not ask his father for bread because he is worthy; A son asks his father for bread because he is hungry."

I have studied revival for over 20 years, and when the Lord quickened that to my spirit, I immediately recognized that common trait: hunger. Great revivals have come and emblazoned men and women of God who were in no way qualified. They weren't great preachers; they weren't great teachers, but they did have this one trait: hunger. One of the greatest revivals in modern history came to Wales in the early 1900's. It came through a 26year-old coal miner named Evan Roberts. Why? Was it because he was a great orator? No, he had never preached a sermon. Was it because he owned a successful business? Not hardly, he worked in the filthy coal mines. There were great men and women of God in those days that God could have used. There were Pastors with large successful churches and large congregations, but in less than three weeks time Evan Roberts went from being an unknown parishioner to being the most famous man in Wales. Suddenly, this man, who was unknown and unqualified, was seeing crowds gather and was preaching to some of the most famous preachers of his day. I submit to you that the main qualification this man had was that he was hungry. You ask what evidence I have. Only this: Evan Roberts did not miss a prayer meeting in his local area for 13 years. He was only 26 when the Welsh Revival began, so for half of his life he was faithful to attend every single prayer meeting in the area where he lived.

The problem we have is not hunger; we are hungry enough; we're just hungry for all the wrong things. We're hungry for more and more earthly treasure! We are not desiring the treasure that Jesus mentioned in Mathew 6:20, "...where moth and rust does not corrupt..." We are consumed with earthly treasure! We in the church continually judge one another on how we are dressed, on what we drive, on the kind of house we live in or on our

latest technology. We have come so far from the truth that, in the church, we actually believe that to have money means that we are the blessed by God. Commonly, we tout that we are "tithers" and that we give, and therefore, God blesses us. All the while, we do not realize that even the ungodly give away money and there are many ungodly who are blessed with great financial wealth.

In Matthew 6:24 Jesus warned that no man can serve two masters. Jesus warned that it is impossible to serve God and mammon. Mammon means not just money, but the deification of wealth worshiping money as a god. In the case I am speaking of, it is the earthly economical system. Yet, Christians commonly chase after money as if it were their god. "Tithers" commonly brag about their tithing and do not realize that we are called to a higher standard. In I Cor 16:2 the standard is set forth for us to give as God has prospered us. Why then do we only give 10%? I submit to you that the vast majority of the church in America has become a covetous people that only give out of our abundance. We gladly tithe and believe for God's blessing but we know nothing of real sacrifice. Jesus warned the rich man. Repeatedly, the rich are warned throughout the scriptures. Mat 6:19, Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth. When we become truly hungry for the things of God it is then that we will see that mighty outpouring we have been praying for. We must, however, desire the true riches, the true manna from Heaven. We must not settle for worldly wealth, worldly esteem, worldly status, which only shows our own lack of spiritual understanding! God give us the grace to become a people that are hungry - hungry for you. Give us the grace to become a generation of spiritual Levites, whose inheritance is not in the world but is the Lord!

shoulders.' You are not part of this wicked government. Know that ideas do not die. This is what formed the government of today. If your skin is lighter than mine, you are better than me. Right? That is a doctrine of demons. Don't think that making America great again is the same thing. The wicked government of the world is not where you belong.

"Jer 29:4, we think that because we are part of this country, we have to accept the evil. The same ideology took people and hung them from trees a few years back. It's not bad; it's evil. The same sin will do it today if we allow the ideology of the evil government to come in. You are carried away captive if you are a blood-bought Christian. The world hated Jesus; they will hate you. This government has taken prayer out of schools, you cannot say Jesus there and you are gonna 'make America great again?' I tell you this because I love you. What can the world give the body of Christ when we have everything? You are in exile because you are in this world, not of it. Go ahead, have children, plant gardens, have success, but do not come under the wickedness of the government system.

"The kingdom of Heaven is a government. Jesus came with an invisible government to give to an invisible people. The kingdom of Heaven is at hand. Repent! I have never seen the church as divided as I have in the past two years. A white bishop said the blacks don't like him because he supports Trump. I say no, it's because you're not like Jesus.

"These so-called churches have no power. What do you call a government that does not work? It is in shut-down. That is what we have in the church – a government shut-down.

"Acts 1:4 says not to leave Jerusalem. We are leaving Jerusalem too soon. We cannot unite the kingdom of God if we don't understand the kingdom of God.

"It rained today; yet there are still people here. You are the primary candidates for the movement of the kingdom. You defy the very government that was placed in your baby bottles. Father, what can we do to become a part of this invisible kingdom you are setting up? Acts 1:5-8, the only thing you have to worry about is receiving power.

"Being nice and cozy – comfortable is great if you are going to sleep, but the world comes and tells you that you can't say the name of Jesus, or wear a T-shirt with his name, it is no longer comfortable.

You will <u>not</u> teach my child about Steve and Sam. It is the invisible kingdom. A DNA test may tell you that I am white. This happened to my daughter. That is one of those stupid thing the world says because they think they understand the Bible when they do not. There is a book in the Bible called, 'Judges.' "We are not hearing about the kingdom of God, so we have to wing it. We hear preaching on all kinds of things, but the Lord gave us Mat 6:33.

"We have unity here, on this level, on the surface—the feel-good level. But if I say something wrong, it's all over because we are on the feel-good level. We live in a democracy. We actually think we should vote on everything. Guess what? In the kingdom of God, you don't get to vote; it's gonna be God's way—he is king. God told Samuel, 'Give them their king. They're not rejecting you; they're rejecting me.' Give their Obama, their Trump.

They reject me, and when they call on me, I won't be there. I have never heard of a 'white evangelical' until this administration. You uncircumcised Philistine, You deny yourself access to the kingdom. The witness is in the miracles, the healing. We must acknowledge and fix it.

"I've seen the alliance change – become more holy. We talk about going to heaven, but God wants us to develop **here**. Let's live for him so we can get the Hitlers of the world saved."



Cody explained that Barry Mason was a man who belonged to the Hell's Angels, rejected that, asked Christ to be his Lord, and started Heaven's Saints Motorcycle Ministry.

Cody and his wife are helping build the youth ministry at Living Hope and in whatever areas that Pastor Allen needs help with. On 13 January, Cody preached for the first time. He began by singing a song (He also helps in the music ministry). Healing began to take place as he sang I Have Got More to Go to Heaven For. "When you have blinders on," Chaplain Cody said, "you pull away. You need to allow the Holy Spirit to use you. The devil will build a cage around your heart. He will hold you there until you don't even

Cody is able to reach those in the gangs, in the world, where the unwritten motto is blood-in, blood-out. Cody is right for this kind of ministry because he has been down that road and he has the wisdom to help those people know the power of the blood of Christ and the transformation. organizations that perform abortions. Many protested, claiming their reproductive rights were being violated.

"Using the term 'reproductive rights' when speaking about abortion is like saying 'freedom rights' when speaking about slavery," Johnny Uspect of Living Word Church told BFN. "All those women have the right to 'reproduce.' In China women don't have that right; they are only allowed two children. The right of those women to reproduce has not been interfered with; only their right to have their unborn children murdered using federal funds. This term is just another one of the euphemisms spewed out by the left - a politically correct term like 'termination of pregnancy' instead of 'abortion.'

"We had a good president, who represented the people." Elizabeth Graves of Winder, Georgia told BFN. This man has not represented the people since he was elected. He has already taken away more of our rights than any other president I can remember.'

"I am pro-choice," stated the reverend Janine Wilton of Freedom in Christ Ministries, "the time for a woman to make that choice, however, is before she has sex, not after. Watch Night Did Not **Originate with American** Slaves

Watch Night services are actually believed to have originated with the Moravians in the 18th century. Here is an article from the internet about it:

As strongly as Watch Night is now linked to the black community, its observance did not originate with that group, nor did it begin on 31 December 1862, the night before the Emancipation Proclamation came into effect.

Watch Night began with the Moravians, a small Christian denomination whose roots lie in what is the present-day Czech Republic. The first such service is believed to have been held in 1733 on the estates of Count Nicholas von Zinzendorf in Hernhut, Saxony.

John Wesley, founder of the Methodist movement, picked it up from the Moravians, incorporating a Watch Night vigil into the practices of his denomination beginning in 1740. Methodist Watch Nights were held once a month and on full moons, with the first such service in the United States reportedly taking place in 1770 at Old St. George's Church in Philadelphia. These services survive to the present day in that denomination's worship manuals as "Covenant Renewal Services." What was being "watched over" in those earlier services was one's covenant with God. Those gatherings were a time for congregants to meditate on their state of grace: were they spiritually ready to meet their maker if the call were suddenly to come? As the 13th chapter of Mark instructs, the faithful need to be ever vigilant, because the hour of the Lord's coming is not known. (Watch ye therefore: for ye know not when the master of the house cometh.)

The end-of-year Watch Night of 1862 took on special significance attaching to the impending 1 January 1863 enactment of the Emancipation Proclamation, and that night has come to be known as "Freedom's Eve." On 22 September 1862, Lincoln his preliminary Emancipation Proclamation, which stated: "[O]n the first day of January ... all persons held as slaves within any State, or designated part of a State, the people whereof shall then be in rebellion against the United States shall be then, thenceforward, and forever free." Lincoln issued the subsequently Emancipation Proclamation itself on 1 January 1863.

While that proclamation did not end slavery the moment it was issued, it did at least proclaim some slaves free. Knowing that this was going into effect the next day must certainly have influenced the nature of that year's Watch Night within the African-American and abolitionist communities, adding a second symbolic layer of what was being watched for (the coming of freedom at the stroke of midnight) to the more usual fare (the coming of the Christ at an unspecified future date and therefore the need to maintain a constant personal state of spiritual preparation). Among African-American congregations, that second layer of meaning has since become permanently woven into the fabric of the original, making New Year's Eve Watch Night services as much now about remembering the end of slavery as it is upon personal reflection on the state of one's soul.

One additional bit of legend has attached to the origin of Watch Night, the dubious claim that slaves would gather on the final night of the year to shiver in fear as they awaited news about which of them would be sold the next day to satisfy outstanding debts. By the lights of that theory, while those so assembled were also watching for the coming of the master, the one they were

keeping an eye out for was going to sell off some of them (as opposed to redeeming their souls and transporting them to life everlasting).

While the practice of entering the New Year free of financial obligation is a very old one (superstition dictates all debts must be retired prior to the beginning of the year), the idea that accounts would be settled on 1 January is unlikely. The first day of the year was a time for paying social calls on one's neighbors, and only the exceedingly gauche would have thought to sully such interactions with so much as a mention of anything business-related, let alone attempt to transact the buying and selling of slaves on that day. Moreover, anyone acting out of desire to enter the New Year clear of debt would fail in that effort if he put off selling or transferring property until the first of January. We, therefore, suggest taking with a large grain of salt Watch Day origins that feature huddled slaves assembled for their one last night together before some of them were sold off.



The night before Jesus was crucified, He took the time to tell Peter and the other disciples what to expect—that he, Jesus, would die, would be raised from the grave, and would meet them later in the Galil (Galilee - see Matthew 26:31–32). He was arrested that same night by armed men –temple guards (not Roman soldiers contrary to many older movies), and taken before the high priest.

The other disciples scattered, but Peter followed behind Jesus—at a distance. When they got to the high priest's courtyard, Peter settled down a little ways away and waited to "see the end." But Jesus had already told Peter and the others what was going to happen and what the end would be.

The Bible says, "Peter followed him at a distance to the high priest's courtyard. And he went in and sat with the servants to see the end" (Matthew 26:58, NKJV).

Many Christians in America today want to follow Jesus at a distance. They want to give themselves a little room; they want to watch which way the wind will blow and see what the end will be.

When Jesus is portrayed in a good light or when it's comfortable, they will stand up there next to him. But if Jesus is going to be mocked or cursed or insulted, they want to stay back until they know how things will go.


