On Prayer 75 Blessing Others (Part one)

Any thorough discussion of prayer would be incomplete without including something specific about blessing others. I would like to bring to you five key points on this subject and the first point deals with **impartation**. By pronouncing a blessing on other people or group(s) of people and putting this principle into practice, we can positively affect our own relationships.

We see this principle in action all throughout the Bible. Gen 48:8-9 says, "When Israel saw the sons of Joseph, he asked, 'Who are these?"

"They are the sons God has given me in this place," Joseph answered his father.

"Then Israel said, "Bring them to me so that I may bless them."

Israel's eyesight was not good just before his death, but he wanted to lay hands on his two grandsons and pronounce a blessing upon them.

While reading this same passage some years ago, the Lord spoke to me and said, "Don't just **read** it; do it! I want you to bless your children. I thought, "Lord, what would I bless them with?"

At that time Richard, who was a pastor, and I had one child that was suffering from "preacher's-kidosis." Immediately I blessed that child with a hunger for God and for his word. Another one of our children always seemed to be close at hand whenever an accident happened. I blessed that child with a careful spirit. Another one of our children seemed to have had sad eyes almost from birth. Concerned about her spirit, I blessed her with a spirit of joy. Then I blessed another of our children with an obedient spirit.

The next day, the child with preacher's-kid-osis was not feeling well and, therefore, stayed home from school. I went in to check on him later in the morning and he was on his bed with Haley's Bible Handbook, Strong's Concordance, The King James Version, the NIV, and the New King James all open. And he was in intensive study. I imparted the desire for God's word into him without nagging, preaching, or saying, 'Hey, you're missing out on God. You don't even worship anymore. What's wrong with you?" I did it secretly in the prayer closet, and the child was supernaturally affected for good.

Ping Pong Balls (Part Three)

Many people believe that faith is on the one side and logic and reason are on the other side. We see this plainly by the worldly dictionary definition of faith. I cannot, however, stress strongly enough that nothing could be further from the truth.

As we have seen, it is not faith one the one side, with logic and reason on the other; but, instead, it is faith and reason on the one side and emotions and imagination on the other. This is an excellent reason not to allow our relationship with God (or anything else in our life) to be ruled by our emotions. There are many times in my life when I don't feel saved. The truth is that it doesn't matter what I feel; what matters is what I know to be true. Even with all these things taken into consideration, there is still a grave misunderstanding among many Christians themselves about faith. misunderstanding seems to be very common, and involves what I call the Ping-pong-ball misconception.

Imagine that I had a large bowl filled with pingpong balls, and on each one was written the word "faith." I set the bowl in the middle in the middle of the floor and tell you to just "Have more faith." You could just reach into the bowl and take as much faith as you want to have. Does that sound absurd? Good! Then you can see the problem. When we tell someone that they just need to "have more faith," we are being just as absurd. We are demonstrating this misconception. We are demonstrating that we do not completely understand how faith works. Well then, exactly how does faith work? To understand this a bit better, let's begin in Rev 12:9, "The great dragon was cut out, that old serpent called the devil, and Satan, which decieveth the whole world." The Bible tells us that Satan deceives the whole world. People, that includes many Christians. He may have to use different tactics with Christians, but knows how to do that. With Christians, he uses things like religion (or religiosity) and traditions. He also uses our pride. I John 4:4 says, "Greater is

he that is in you than he that is in the world." We have all seen people who are very zealous and misunderstand this scripture. If we are not very careful, our pride will run with this scripture. Remember, it says, "greater is he," not greater is me. We ourselves are not more powerful, not more intelligent that the forces of darkness. We have to have the Lord's power to deal with them, not our own. Don't forget the sons of Sceva.

Learning to be a Soul Winner Step-by-step training

The Right Approach to Soul Winning



Les (Brother Pineapple) Vinluan the evangelist One important thing we need to understand is that Jesus cane to die for one reason: to forgive sin and to save mankind. Luke 19:10 says, "For the Son of Man came to seek and to save that which was lost." Mark 16:15 says to "preach the gospel to every creature" (KJV).

Today, we have a dangerous approach to evangelism. Our modern churches present salvation as a means to better life: to find God's plan for your life; to find happiness in your life; to have your problems solved; to experience an abundant life; etc. Yet we see many of God's people experiencing many difficulties in their "Christian life."

To entice someone to get saved so that they will have a better life is misleading. Read Fox's Book of Martyrs and see how real salvation turned out for them. Of the New Testament saints, Philip, Andrew, Kefa (Peter), Sh'mon the Zealot, Natan'el Bar-talmai (Nathaniel Bartholomew), and Ya'akov Bar-Chalfai (James son of Alphaeus, aka James the less were all crucified (Peter upside down, and James the less was clubbed almost to death first); L'vi Ben-Chalfai (Mattityahu or Matthew) and Ya'akov Bar-Zavdai (James son of Zebedee) both were beheaded with the sword; T'oma (Thomas) was killed with a spear upon his return home from India; Bar-Nabba (Barnabus) was burned, Yochanan called Mark was dragged to death, Paul was beheaded, Dr Luke was hanged, Ya'akov the brother of Yeshua was stoned to death, Polycarp (the associate pastor of the church at Ephesus when John the apostle was pastor and later became the pastor) was burned and run through with a sword, and Yochanan Bar-Zavdai was boiled in oil (John was boiled, however, it did not harm him miraculously. Therefore he was exiled to Patmos and it is said be died of natural causes. There is no actual record, however, of his death at all).

Still the approach of many churches today is "Come and enjoy this wonderful new life in Christ." This produces a shallow and wrong motive for salvation; there is little or no preaching against sin; there is no conviction for sin in the salvation process. This produces many false professions and is the primary reason that 60 to 80% of churched people are unsaved.

Therefore, when we win souls, we need to present the real plan of salvation, not just have them say the "Sinner's Prayer" and let them be, and either disciple them (making sure they know that this is

part of the plan) or arrange for someone qualified and responsible to disciple them.

Called to do the Work

We are called for something else as well. We are called to do the work that it takes to bring the whole body of Christ into one body, as the Bible tells us to. There are groups of Christians around the state, around the country and around the world that exist to do this very thing and they need your help because we are all called to do this. In John 17:20-21 Jesus himself prayed, "I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in me through their word; that they all may be one, as you, Father are n me, and I in you; that they may be one in us, that the world may believe that you sent me."

People, we need to stop acting as if the kingdom of God is all about our church and what our church is doing, as if we were the only ones headed to the kingdom.

Brother Rick Hempton told a story of what happened when his daughter asked Christ into her life. She went on a mission trip to Haiti just after the earthquake in 2010 because she spoke French. In the church compound where she was, a Voodoo temple was less than a mile away. When she could get none of the church people to go with her, she went alone to witness to the people there. She spoke to the Voodoo priest, who said, "All you Christians say something different. You should get yourselves together and then come back to talk to me." This is exactly what the world sees in us. Jesus prayed that we all be one, then he said why: so that the world will know that he was sent by the Father. The world can never know that as long as we stay this divided, especially in America.

The harvest is ready, but the laborers are few. There is a group of churches in Barrow, Jackson, Hall, Walton, Gwinnett, Oconee, and Clarke Counties that exists to do this work. It is the Whole Body of Christ Alliance, the WBCA. There are other alliances as well, like One People Ministries, operating in Georgia, Ohio, Florida, Arizona, and Texas. In August 12,000 of 2018 people gathered at Stone Mountain to move to bring the whole body together. We are not talking about ecumenicalism everyone compromising their beliefs until we all believe the same thing. I am talking about being different and continuing to be different, but loving each other, staying close to each other, supporting each other, and celebrating our differences. I am not talking about one world religion. I am talking about coming together with our brothers and sisters in Christ, because, if we don't do it, and do it now, we will not be able to survive in what is very quickly coming upon us.

If you have read this far in this article, you know that what I am saying is true. I urge you, I beseech you, to turn to page 7, get the information for contacting the Whole Body of Christ Alliance. If you are willing to work for the kingdom of God - I mean actually work, not just talk about it like most people do - turn some pages, make a call and do this work.



"In Chapter 15 of Luke, we see the story of the prodigal son. He returned thinking, 'what am I gonna say to my father?' The father said, 'Kill the fattened calf. We are gonna party tonight.' Don't run after Christianity; run after Jesus; run after God."

the most dangerous things in America is a professing Christian that does whatever they want. We must surrender. It is not a get-out-of-Hell free card. Jesus came to restore the garden and us to the Father. Don't confuse grace with mercy. Grace is empowerment, but not to empower you to sin. I am not a 'sinner saved by grace' – the same old person with a few bandages. No! I am a new creature. Deny yourself, pick up your cross and follow me. Jesus did not come to make bad people good; but to make dead people live. Jesus said you will know my disciples by their fruit. That fruit is love. The whole 'morality' thing leads to religiosity. Focus on Jesus, not Christianity. Jesus washed you with his blood so you could bear his image.

"It's not sinful just to be human, but a human with sin does not bear his image. When people see that new creature you are, they will become convicted because you bear his image. Jesus said, 'Stop resurrecting stuff I killed.'

I was in India last year, one of the most persecuted places on earth. Over 8000 churches were burned there last year alone. Be grateful; we can go up to someone here and pray without a riot starting or people harming you. Here the only hindrance to healing is believing there's a hindrance to healing. My wife had a dream about a young girl in India with her hair down, wearing a yellow dress, and standing beside a busy highway and a multistory building. When I went to India, this is the girl I met. Very few girls wear their hair down, but there she was, beside this busy highway and multistory building. Her dress looks white in the picture, but is

actually yellow. Another little girl was deaf, but now she can hear."

Bible study in your garage was illegal. The Whole Body of Christ Alliance led by Greg Brockman of North Georgia Revival Outreach showed up at the board of commissioners meeting and called attention to the unconstitutionality of this county ordinance.

On 16 June 2014 the WBCA gathered outside the courthouse in Jackson County to pray. BFN was in B&W in those days.

"We don't enforce that," the WBCA was told.
"You may not enforce it completely," countered Greg Brockman, "but first of all, someone else could be in office in a few years who hates God and his people, and they would enforce it. Second, it was enforced when a county employee shut down a tent revival on private property."

"We attended two of the meetings of the board of commissioners," said Herman Parks of the board of directors of the WBCA. "The Commissioners themselves always greatly outnumbered the people in the courtroom. When the WBCA should up that day, the courtroom was packed out with concerned Christians."

"They never had an armed guard when we came for the board meetings," Pastor Allen Stevens told BFN, "but they were a little intimidated that day and they sure had an armed guard that day."

The law was changed and it only took three months.


