On Prayer 82 Touching God's Heart (Part One)

Although the way we pray is important, it is not a matter of mechanics. You don't want to just show up with a list of prayer requests either. Prayer enables a believer to know God and fall in love with him. It would be absurd in a relationship between a bride and a groom for the bride to show up with a list of things she wanted from her husband. A bride and groom enjoy a love relationship because they are married.

We, the body of Christ, are his bride. We need a relationship in which we come to know our husband's heart. That relationship develops with prayer, which is the very thing that brings interaction between Messiah and his bride.

The reason prayers go "weird" is that they become separated from the relationship with God. A relationship produces revelation, which produces faith. Rom 10:17 tells us that faith comes by hearing the word of God. I know that many people think Paul is talking about hearing someone preach the word of God, but if you think about it, listening to someone preach has never been very effective in bringing about anyone's faith. Actually, the word rendered "word" in this verse is rhema (not logos, which is the written word of God). Rhema is Greek, meaning the spoken word of God. We receive faith when God himself speaks a word to us, and that faith produces fruit.

In contrast, mechanical formulas produce imaginings, and imaginings produce false faith or hyper-faith, which in turn produce weird works. Webster's New Collegiate Dictionary defines "weird" as follows:

"Of, relating to, or caused by witchcraft or the supernatural; magical."

"On the other hand," Henry countered, "eastern religions stress praying and meditating **inwardly**. If you ask me, that makes even less sense than praying to an inanimate universe."

"I agree, Henry. Anyway, let's get back to the Old Testament passage I just read. What I quoted was spoken by an enemy of Israel. Essentially, that enemy was asking who King Hezekiah of Israel was depending on. Obviously, the king was depending on God."

"What's your point with all of this?"

"If you're going to take the time to pray to the Lord, you need to understand that he is unbelievably powerful. You must also realize that you're praying to he who made it all. In other words, you're not praying to an impotent wimp. You're praying to an incredibly powerful God – the real God – the one who made everything from nothing.

A Pastor's Mandate (Part One)

Giving honor to whom it is due is scriptural (Romans 13:7). So is having those who are honored live up to what scripture expects or stipulates. One office in the Church today we need to look at critically in the light of the word of GOD is that of **the pastor**. This is because many of us go by that title by God's grace and we need to live up to God's mandate. This is because God's accountability comes to us all soon.

So to begin with, who is a pastor according to God's word? The real pastor is a person chosen by God and anointed by the Holy Spirit and is one of the Five-fold Ministry enumerated by Paul the apostle in Eph 4:11-12. It is by virtue of this that he, in the Holy Spirit, leads the congregation.

A pastor is basically a shepherd with a flock which he must account for. Pastors must have a congregation of sorts. Remember the quorum set in Mat 18:20 - "For where two or three are gathered together in my name, I am there in the midst of them." Neither do they need to meet in a church building. The early church met also in the homes of the members, where they are together. Acts 2:46 NKJV "So continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, they ate their food with gladness and simplicity of heart." Romans 16:3-4, "Greet Pricilla and Aquila... ...likewise greet the church that is in their house." The pastor must guard this congregation as in Heb 13:20-21 KJV, "Now the God of Peace that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant." The scriptural method is, among others, as outlined in the famed Psalm 23.

To be a good shepherd of his flock, the pastor must bear in mind God's admonition in Ezekiel 33:1-10 and especially verses 6 and 7 thus "But if the watchman sees the sword coming and does not blow the trumpet, and the people are not warned, and the sword comes and takes any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood I will require at the watchman's hand. So you, son of man: I have made you a watchman for the house of Israel; therefore you shall hear a word from my mouth and warn them for

Accordingly, he must teach and preach to his sheep the entire Bible, which is the whole word of God -Genesis to Revelation for II Tim 3:16-17 says: "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work". (see also Psalm 19:7) It is thus unacceptable for a pastor to personally pick and choose which part of scripture to teach and which to avoid. Selective obedience, aptly said, is disobedience. It is like underfeeding the flock and it will come back to hurt shepherd and sheep. The pastor teaches what God directs under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

It is important to emphasize that a Pastor's main job is three-fold. Firstly, and most important, every pastor must have a true and intimate personal relationship with God. It starts with the pastor first - charity, as we know, begins at home. Thus, a pastor must make it a point daily to read the Bible, pray (to include praying in tongues) and seek to hear what God has for him for the day. He must do this daily for this ensures he stays holy before God. Please note the apostles' decision in Acts 6:1-7. It reads "Now in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplying, there arose a complaint against the Hebrews by the Hellenists, because their widows were neglected in the daily distribution. Then the twelve summoned the multitude of the disciples and said, 'It is not desirable that we should leave the word of God and serve tables. Therefore, brethren, seek out from among you seven men of good reputation, full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business; but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word." And the saying pleased the whole multitude. And they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and the Holy Spirit, and Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolas, a proselyte from Antioch, whom they set before the apostles; and when they had prayed, they laid hands on them. Then the word of God spread, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were obedient to the faith.' (NKJV) Secondly a pastor must teach the entire word of God accurately. This means everything from Genesis to Revelation. So as the Bible says, the pastor needs to 'Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth' (I Timothy 2:15). This is the only way he can effectively teach the entire word of God. One major legal maxim is Nemo dat quod non habet. In other words, you cannot give what you do not have. If you don't know what God's word says, how can you teach and rightly divide the word of truth? By teaching the word of God effectively to his sheep, he equips them such that they are able to use the word of God to solve the problems, issues and matters they encounter in their individual Christian journey daily. This is because not everyone can have access to his pastor every minute of the day.

If well equipped, the member of the flock will stand in the face of battle as David did and declare in daily battles, "You come to me with a sword, with a spear, and with a javelin. But I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom you have defied. This day the Lord will deliver you into my hand, and I will strike you and take your head from you. And this day I will give the carcasses of the camp of the Philistines to the birds of the air and the wild beasts of the earth, that all the earth may know that there is a God in Israel." (I Samuel 17: 45-46)

These two parts of the pastor's main job are very essential for a pastor, but he may, from time to time, be led to reconcile people who come his way to God using the Bible too (II Corinthians 5:18). Preaching salvation so that souls can join those already in the pastor's pen is also a part, though not necessarily essential per his mandate. (Evangelists are mandated to preach to bring

in lost souls and once souls are won, they are the pastor's responsibility and it is his prerogative so to say.)

Testimony from Florida State Prison (Part two)

I was in prison and I got married, but I was still on the wrong team. Although I was the MVP, I was still playing for the wrong team and God very strongly and strictly reminded me. I still wasn't doing the right thing. I had money and I had family and I was leading them away. I kind of feel like Job. Everything I had I lost - my money, my possessions, my wife, my kids, everything. My health began failing and I took a turn for the worse. Every time I used the bathroom, I would bleed badly. I'd spit up blood and I was in constant pain. One day after I came back from the outside hospital, they sent me to a medical prison and I was placed in a cell with roaches and rats. I felt like I was losing my mind. I would pace back and forth in pain. I was crying and I looked at an old e-mail from my former wife. She said, "Depend on God no matter what."

As I was reading this e-mail, I was incapable of saying "God." I kept trying to speak the word unsuccessfully. I began to panic. I began weeping violently. I could not breathe. It felt like someone was choking me. I went to the mirror and saw that my eyes were wide and red not bloodshot, but glowing red. A voice not my own said, "You wanted death; now you're gonna see what your wish brings." An evil laugh was emitted from me, but it was not me. I began vomiting into the toilet and choking. I fell to the floor and tried to pray out loud. I was in a vision where my former wife and my children were in caskets. Then there was a large number of people around me laughing and pointing at me. I was finally able to scream out "Jesus!" Then I prayed, "In the name of Jesus Christ, help me!" I was able to begin reciting the Lord's Prayer and the horror dissipated, it all went away. I stood there for what seemed like hours weeping and praying.

A couple of months later, I was moved to another prison and put into a cell with bars. It was like a dungeon. There were three floors and it always seemed dark. The back wall was cement and so were the walls on either side and the front of the cell was iron bars. Ps 107:16 says, "He has broken the gates of bronze and cut the bars of iron in sunder.

I found a Bible in the bottom of the locker in the new cell. I opened it and Ps 107 was the exact place I opened to. From that point on, I have been battling the forces of darkness on my knees. I began to study the Bible and not just read it. I began praying at length and actually talking and listening to God. I began fasting, worshiping and praising our mighty Father's name. He is an on-time God. He may not come when you want him, but he's always right on time.

People, we need to be talking to every believer we know or meet and reminding them what the Bible says about being in unity with the rest of the body of Christ.

Before you do this, however, realize that some will listen and some will not. When they do not listen. do not be discouraged. Do not stop talking to other believers. To do this, it is best to enlist the aid of someone close and always take it to the Lord.

Some will listen because you are telling the truth of Almighty God. Some will not listen because they may believe, like far too many do, that they have the whole truth and no one else does. You may even be part of a denomination or church that believes that way. It is far more common than some might believe. But the truth is that not even one denomination, one church or one pastor has the whole truth, and we are not going to get the whole truth until we come together.

We can avoid this pitfall of thinking we have the whole truth if we can look at ourselves. If we judge ourselves, there is no need for the Lord to judge us. If we listen to the alarm system the Lord gave us that reminds us to look at ourselves, we can do and be what God wants. So be it.

"That is when I came to work for my mother at the trucking company and I was able to spend more time with my daughter. Suddenly, my little girl started getting unexplainable bruises. My baby sitter asked one of my friends if I was beating her. Then at a birthday party, one of the kids bit her on the arm and it spread

all the way up her arm. I knew something was not right and called the doctor's office, but I was leary of them because I didn't want them to try to take Tabby away from me. She got a fever and I thought she was getting a cold. I stayed up with her a couple of nights. Then she had only one sippie cup to drink all day and she threw it up. At the time her temperature was 104.7°, she was not urinating and was dehydrated, so I grabbed her up and took her to the hospital in Gainesville

"After running some tests, the doctor told me she had leukemia. I didn't know what leikemia was, but I asked him what he was going to do and he told me they were going to life flight her to Atlanta. When she got to the hospital in Atlanta, they took her straight back. When I had answered all their questions, they took me to her and the sign on the wall in the ward said, 'Aflac Cancer Center' I still didn't know what leukemia was and they said, 'We're gonna give you a tour because this is where you will be living for the next couple years.' I spent the next 2 1/2 years in outpatient. It was rough.

"She had friends 18-years-old and friends five-yearsold. Every one of her friends passed away. She did not talk for the first couple of weeks because she was mad at me for letting them do all those things to her, but

after the first ICU incident, they brought her to her room and she didn't talk for two or three days. Then I asked her, 'Do you wanna go outside?' She was all about that. They unhooked her from the pole and when she went out the door, all the staff gave her a standing ovation. She was Ms Hollywood after that. She didn't like losing her hair, but she was all about coming in and greeting and talking to everybody.

"We were in the hospital most of the time, so I would lose whatever house I had. God was getting me ready not to need material things. My daughter and I had a conversation and I told her, 'Pretty soon you're gonna get to go be with Jesus and you won't have to worry about hurting. There won't be anymore pokies or medicine. You will just run and play and not worry about anything.

I went to check on her and she was still breathing, but she was not waking up. I didn't know it at the time, but it was the Holy Spirit that woke me up and told me what was about to happen.

I was on the couch and the nurse told me I'd better get in there and tell her it was okay to go. I held her hand and, as soon as I told her, 'Baby girl, it's okay to go see Jesus,' that was it. So I thanked the Lord that he woke

When we were kids, my mom made us get on the church bus. So I had a limited knowledge of who Jesus was. But what God did for me through all of that was show me that I had to know that I knew. So when she was buried, the enemy came to me and said, 'So, do you really believe?' I could not, at the time, answer yes, but I knew that <u>I</u> was going to find out. I began a mission to do just that. I went to every church around and Bible colleges. I can say today that I wouldn't be here if all that in 2002 had not happened. I can stand in front of you and tell you that Jesus is real. The enemy will always come and try to give you doubt, but you can know that you know. All glory to God.

"Most every one follows the world's idea of Valentine's Day. Some Christians believe that it is a pagan holiday because of the little Cupid on the Valentine cards with his bow and arrow. Cupid was a Roman god and is definitely pagan. Just like almost every Christian holiday, including Resurrection Day, the enemy has stolen it from us and we have allowed it. None of this has anything to do with the real Valentine. Valentine was a real person and he was a Christian martyr. In the first century, Claudius was Emperor of Rome. He was pretty fed up with his officers always wanting time off for their families. So he made it a law that no one could get married. People, of course, did it anyway. Some Christian priests refused to marry people because it was against the law. Others married people even though it was illegal. Valentine was an unmarried Christian priest (He was not a Catholic priest; the Catholic church didn't come along until the fourth century. The fact that nuns and priest take a vow of celebasy comes from the pagans, more specifically, those who ran the temple of the goddess Vesta, could not be married).

"Valentine would perform illegal weddings in secret and more than once He performed a wedding while running through the streets of Rome away from the Roman guards. It could be that he wasn't caught because most of the Roman guards knew the law was nonsense. One day, however, he was caught by the Romans and imprisoned for his crime. He was very well liked by the jailer and the other prisoners. The daughter of the jailer was blind, but it was her job to bring the food to the prisoners. Valentine told her about Jesus, his crucifixion, resurrection and told her that she was actually eligible to become one of his if she wanted to. He laved hands on her and healed her of the blindness in the name of Jesus. Having received her sight, she asked Jesus to be her Lord and became a Christian. Not long after, She and Valentine were married. Valentine wrote a short note to the jailer's daughter and signed it 'Your Valentine.' This is the source of the tradition of asking people to be your Valentine and the source of the tradition of getting Valentine cards.

"There were many different religious practices in Rome; there was the worship of the familiar Greco-Roman gods, of whom Zeus was the chief god. There were also many who worshiped the Babylonian gods and other gods as well. There were many Christians because there was a church in Rome. Unlike those of the other relgions, however, Christians were not tolerated. It was very much like today in the USA. In fact then, Christians were persecuted. Those who were not Roman citizens (most of them) could be killed in any means that pleased the authorities at the time. Roman citizens, however, had to executed humanely, usually by beheading (e.g.. Paul the apostle).

"Christians in the USA are not persecuted like that today. Christian martyrs of today are mostly in other countries; the Christians I know get put out when the air conditioning is not placed down on 70.

"In those days Christians were killed in gruesome ways, usually in the Coliseum. They were killed in very imaginative, but gruesome ways. They were killed by wild animals in the arena or by gladiators. They were crucified in other places and the wealthy would often have them nailed to a tall stake, dowsed in tar and set on fire. They would burn all through the night as night lights for parties. One lady was placed in a net and a bull gored her until she was dead. Usually there were several and they would have to watch the one ahead of them die, knowing they were next.

"What are you doing to suffer for Jesus?

no real fellowship until you break bread together. I'm not talking about communion Sunday morning. When you break bread together, it causes you to show and to see the real person. When you fellowship, you will "In II Chron 7:14, God said, 'When the world humbles itself and prays?' No! 'When your denomination

humbles itself and prays?' No! 'When my people...' "For unity in the body of Christ, we need the six Ps:

1: Prayer - We absolutely have to be in prayer. Acts1:14, 'continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Miryam the mother of Yeshua and with his brothers.'

2: the Purpose of Almighty God - Acts 2:46, 'They continued daily with one accord... ...with gladness and singleness of heart.'

3: Lift him up in **Praise** - Acts 4:24, '...they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, "Lord, you are God, which has made Heaven, and Earth, and the sea, and all that is in them.

4: the Power of God - Acts 5:12, 'by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought'

5: Boldly Preach - Acts 8:4-6, 'they that were scattered abroad went everywhere preaching the word. Philip went down to Samaria and preached Christ to them... ... for unclean spirits crying with a loud voice came out of many that were possessed.'

6: Godly Peace - Acts 15:24-25, many religiose men tried to make the Gentiles obey the Law of Moses. So the leader of the church in Jerusalem, Ya'akov (James) the brother of Yeshua sent a letter to them: ...we have heard that some that went out from us have troubled you with words... ...It seemed good to us, being assembled with one accord, to send chosen men to you with our beloved Bar-Nabba and Paul.'

"There is another P that is often a product of doing the first six. That is Persecution. Acts 19:29, when Paul and his companions were in Ephesus, the silver smiths, who made their living selling miniature likenesses of the Goddess Artemis (Dianna), caused severe trouble for them.

"With persecution there are often good things too. Sometimes God has to take you down to take you up. When you are in a swimming pool, you go down to the bottom to kick off for the surface. Sometimes you have to go to the bottom to get back up.

"If this fellowship is gonna grow, there are some things we will have to do and Acts 2:47 - and God added to their number. God will take us to another level."

Salvation, Pass the Mic

II Tim 2:15 says, 'Study to show yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

A great fault with many is the acceptance of only part of the scripture and the rejection of other scripture that contradicts their theory.

I will use all the scripture on salvation by grace rather than by works. These are particularly important when witnessing to a Mormon, a Jehova's Witness, a Muslim or even fellow Christians. It is important to know why we believe what we believe.

"Eph 2:8 says, 'For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is a gift of God.' Those who operate in pride do not have a good revelation of salvation by grace. They are under the delusion that God saved them and/or uses them because of some merit of their own. Once we see how destitute of any worthiness we are on our own, humble ourselves and receive salvation as a gift, then boasting is excluded. (God has not saved me and does not love me because of anything that has to do with me; instead it is an expresion of who God is). God has designated salvation in such a way as to eliminate any boasting. If salvation were even partially by works, then men could boast. But grace and faith alone eliminate man's ability to boast. It brings praise and glory to God. If we could save ourselves even partially, we would take the credit for it. All the glory goes to God.

"Eph 2:9 says, 'not of works lest any man should boast.' No one deserves salvation. It cannot be earned by what the Bible calls dead works, which includes all religious activity, good deeds and/or charity that somene might do in order to be justified before God. Faith in God and what he has done through Jesus Christ is the only means of receiving salvation. To trust in any human work or effort as a means of salvation is to fall from grace and separate one's self from the savior. No one can be saved by the combination of grace and works because they are mutually exclusive with regard to salvation. We must be saved by grace through faith alone. Otherwise, your works must meet the standards of God's perfection, Therefore, we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the works of the law. The phrase 'works of the law' is used seven times in the New Testament. What are 'works of the law?' Any rule a man attempts to keep perfectly in order to be accepted into right standing with God, is a work of the law. In other words, works of the law are righteousnesses produced by one's self (i.e. self righteousness) and offered to God as a means of meeting his standards

"Phil 3:9 says, 'not having my own righteousness, which is found in the law, but that which is through faith in Christ,' a righteousness belonging to me, which comes from obeying the law perfectly. Works of the law have always been man's attempt to be accepted by God. Paul said, 'Let me be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but which is through faith in Christ, the righteousness that comes from God and is by faith. It takes a radical revelation of the gospel of grace to abandon faith in the works of the law. God's standard of righteousness is God's alone. In stark contrast to the works of the law, there is the principle of the works of faith. These may be the same exact actions that others perform as works of the law, but the motivation is entirely different. Works of faith are the fruit of the relationship with God; whereas works of the law are done to try to obtain that relationship with God.



Henry Kidd the evangelist of Inner Fountain is another participant.

"Rom 3:27 says, 'Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? No, but by the law of faith.' Faith is governed by law. That means it is universal and constant, just like gravity. If we ignore the law of gravity, we can die. Likewise, if we ignore the law of faith, even through ignorance, we could die. Faith can be relied upon more than any physical thing that is governed by physical laws, such as electricity. Boasting, bragging, false humility and pride about our holiness and spiritual accomplishments are sure signs that we do not understand justification by grace through faith. We must acknowledge that we are no better (holier) than anyone else regardless of our accomplishments. The only way to obtain peace than with God is by putting our faith in what Jesus did for us."

Naomi's husband and both her sons died and she was left with Orpah and Rut. She decided to go back to her people in Bethlehem. She told Orpah to stay in Moab, so she did. Rut would not leave her and went with Naomi to Bethlehem, where she met Boaz and they were the great grand parents of King David. Therefore, they were direct ancestors of Yeshua (Jesus).

"This was such a wonderful example of unity. When life deals you a bad hand of cards, your real friends never leave you. Naomi was an Israelite, so Rut converted from the pagan religion of Moab to Judaism so she could remain united with Naomi. A house divided cannot stand."



Biblical Knowledge

Rock of Israel is one of three Messianic ministries in the alliance. I have been a Christian for a long time and I keep hearing people say what I used to think: "Passover? That's a Jewish thing." The truth is that it's a Christian thing too. The Bible says (Ex 12:14) that Passover is to be observed forever ("an everlasting ordinance"), not just until Jesus comes. The Passover Seder is exactly what Jesus and his 12 boys were doing at the "Last Supper." Many Christians think that Jews and Christians are mutually exclusive, but what was the first church? It was entirely Jewish. As Christians we are "grafted in" to the chosen people of God, the Israelites. The Messianic Congregations are the same as that first Christian church. They are Jewish Christians.

I went to the Seder at Tzur Yisrael last year. It was fantastic. You will learn all about that Last Supper. Why did Jesus do what he did, say what he said? Come find out. Someone told me it is not unheard of for it to cost \$100. You can do it for \$20.

There has not been a **worship only** service for the WBCA since 2013. If you have never been to one, you will kick yourself it you miss it. It's not a regular church service. You will want to be there.
