# On Prayer 94 Call to prayer (Part Six)

Praying the word of God leads us to walking in the word of God. The will of God becomes our greatest delight. That is what King David commented on when he wrote, "I delight to do thy will, oh my God: yea, thy law is within my heart" (Ps 40:8 KJV).

E.M. Bounds went into detail on this theme in his book, *The Necessity of Prayer*: "Prayer draws its very life from the Bible. It places its security on the firm ground of scripture. Its very existence and character depend on revelation made by God to man in his holy word. Prayer, in turn, exalts this same revelation and turns men toward that word. The nature, necessity, and all-comprehending character of prayer is based on the word of God."

The power of prayer flows from the word of God. "He that comes to God must believe that he [God] is, and that he is a rewarder of those who diligently seek him" (Heb 11:6 NKJV). When the revelation of the word of God comes to our hearts (to our insides, when it is more than just head knowledge), we get this kind of faith. It is the kind of faith that God always rewards. When we meditate on that word, when we pray its truths, our belief in God as our rewarder is reinforced.

It has been said that Satan trembles when he sees the weakest saint upon his knees. The devil is quite cunning and when he devises a way to keep us from praying, he feels successful. **When we have a lack or even a great deficiency of prayer, the evil one becomes enabled to lay snares for us to cause us to sin, to stumble, to fall.** As Andrew Bonar pointed out, "The one concern of Satan is to keep the saints from prayer; he fears nothing from prayerless studies, prayerless work, prayerless religion. He laughs at our toil, mocks at our wisdom, and trembles when we pray." This is even truer when we learn to pray more and more effectually.

### God is in Control

We've all heard that statement hundreds of times: God is in control. Is God in control? I'm just asking because the Bible never once says that. Think about this: The Bible says, "And God said, 'Let us make man in our image... ..and let them rule... ..over all the earth'" (Gen 1:26 NIV). Most of the BFN readers remember Cameron Webb, an incarcerated brother who ministers to his brothers in prison. He writes to BFN often and we include one of his sermons below.

### The Disease of Sin

Scripture reading: Ps 51

Scripture focus: "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9 ESV). We are offered a full pardon for our sins. We can accept it or reject it. As insane as it sounds, most people choose to reject it. Reception of the full pardon is the only cure for the disease of sin. In this message I will demonstrate to you a full picture of that truth. You will also see the seriousness of the grave warning given to the sinner.

I remember taking trips across town as a little boy in the family car. Dad drove, mom was in the passenger seat and we kids were in back. We all rolled down our windows because there was no air conditioning in our Ford Granada. I would always get a seat by the (see pg 4)

people who said they would help me, but never did. There is one woman, who found out I had been in a bad situation, who said, 'Why didn't you say something? I would've helped. I did say something and she never helped.'

"I know you are in a bad space right now, Jill," I told her, "but, don't forget the people who **have** helped you out, the people who **did** call you back. And you are right; not all are in unity. That is why we hold the seven-day revivals – so we never stop working to obtain that unity. You were not around in 2010, but if you compare where we were in 2010 to where we are now, you can see it – how far we have come. I know you are in a bad space, but speaking negative things will not help. Speaking them **will** make them worse, however. Instead, what if we looked for the things that **are** working – the people and ministries that have been changed for good because we are doing what we are doing? There are people and ministries that work together that would not even know each other if we had not been doing this."

"You're right," she said, "it's just that the things God tells you, you have to act on. I had a plan for the ministry God directed me to. I am carrying it out. I had the vision to build what I have been doing. I put it on paper – wrote it down so I could carry it out. Habakkuk 2:2 says, 'Write the vision make it plain...'

"I'm sorry, Jill. I have to pull you back on track here. Habakkuk 2:2 is talking about a vision – a revelation, an oracle; not a plan to do something. I know a lot of people misunderstand that piece of scripture. They think it is talking about a vision **statement**, or a mission statement. The Hebrew word there is Khaw-zone. It means the oracle itself, not the plan you make to carry out what God has shown

you. It is the vision itself. I'm not saying we should not make a plan and write it down. We should, but that is not what Hab 2:2 is saying."

"We **do** need to make a plan and write it down. Has anyone in the Whole body of Christ Alliance ever actually done that?"

"It's in the Battlefield News, Jill, page seven. It **has** been written down."

"I've never seen that. Does it come out in every issue?"

"Yes, every issue, page 7."

"I just see so much that is wrong. There's one person that has to run outside and smoke during the revivals. They miss a lot. Then they come back in and lay hands on people smelling like smoke."

"Sweetie, you are in an uncomfortable place right now. We've all been there. It makes us look at things in a negative light. It has happened to me more than once. I cannot allow myself to stay there if I am going to continue to do the work of our Lord. I must focus on the things that **are** working."

"I am a seer. Pastor James Walker is a seer. Pastor James Loyless is a seer. I am just saying what is the truth."

"Jill, there is a Hebrew word – lashon harah. It means 'evil speech.' It is a sin. It includes gossip and false witness, but it also includes speaking negative things about people, even things about yourself. It includes griping and complaining. It also includes negative things that you believe are true. It's one thing to bring it up in an attempt to help correct it, but another thing just to speak it because it happens to be true. You can bring it up to them. You can pray for them. But if there is nothing you can do to change it, you have to dwell on the good, not the things that are wrong."

"Well, I don't have to associate with people like that."

"No, you're right. You don't. But, don't forget, with all these things that you see wrong with other people, Mat 7:1 tells us not to condemn or we will be condemned. What I have to do in these situations is look at myself. I may not smoke and lay hands on people, but I know there are things about me that have to change to be more like the Lord. If I concentrate on what is wrong with everybody else, it makes it real hard to concentrate on what I can do to make myself more like my Lord. There is so much that is right – that is working - for me to be too upset about what is not."

These conversations take place in the work of God anywhere. I ask you, all of you, to do good, not to do evil, not to speak evil, even if you perceive it is true. Bring these things to a member of the board of directors. If the person is not acting as they should, it will come out. But do not commit **lashon harah**. When you speak about some one, as Pastor Billy Angel says, you are prophesying over them.

window and as soon as we were in traffic, our parents would light their cigarettes. The smoke would fly out of the front windows and be sucked into the rear windows and I would catch all the smoke in my face. This was by far the worst part of the trip. My siblings and I would fight the smoke until they were finished smoking, then deal with the stench until we arrived at our destination. When the car came to a stop we would pile out like we were being released from a torture chamber.

When I was older, I remembered reading a warning on the side of a pack of cigarettes from the Surgeon General about the effects of smoking. All I can remember are the words, "may cause cancer." Later in life I discovered that the Surgeon General was the head of the Public Health Service. In this particular field you cannot go any higher than his authority. You can, therefore, take this warning as "gospel." Simply put, **believe it!** But sadly, most smokers, who never heeded the warning of the Surgeon General were never effected or persuaded by that warning nor were they dissuaded by the devastation they witnessed in the lives of other smokers. Even today there are countless people that take chances with smoking unto death for five minutes of pleasure.


## Crossing the Red Sea Again


"The Bible says, 'And the Lord spake unto Moses, "Speak unto the children of Israel, that they turn and encamp before Pi-Hahiroth (Pihahiroth), between Migdol and the sea, over against Ba'al Tz'fon (Baal-zephon): before it shall ye encamp by the sea'" (Ex 14:1-2 KJV).

God was telling them to wait, turn around and camp there. The Israelis said, 'Because there were no graves in Egypt, have you taken us away to die in the wilderness?' (Ex 14:11 NKJV). To the natural eye, it appeared there was a catastrophe in the making.

"Pihahiroth is the name changed. The original word was Heyruth, which means freedom. They had become physically free, but not spiritually. Ba'al Tz'fon was one of the last Egyptian gods, an idol worshiped by the Canaanites. It was a sea-faring idol dealing with commerce. They were leaving Egypt, the superpower of the world and God said to stop. Pharaoh heard that they had camped there by the sea and believed that Ba'al Tz'fon (Baal Zephon) would not allow them to cross. God was aware of this and had something great in mind. The Israelis were experiencing something that had not happened for hundreds of years.



Pi-hahiroth is on the shore of the Gulf of Suez (Red Sea). The red line marks the original path; the yellow is the point where they turned.


"Pharaoh thought he was going to destroy the Israelites and defeat their God. There are people today that believe the same thing. (BFN: God baited this pagan king to get him and his army right where our God wanted them to be. He will do exactly the same thing to those today that believe they will defeat him and his people. Today it is not Pharaoh; it is the antichrist and the United Nations). Between this past Thursday and Friday there was a spirit of despair because America had placed their hope in a person, an administration. God saw this and is setting something else up. It is imperative that we trust **in him**.

"Pharaoh thought the wilderness had trapped the descendants of Israel and he believed he would go in and vanquish them. In our spiritual life, we find triumphs in spiritual battle and we come to a place where there is a physical block (like the Israelites at the Red Sea). We think it is the enemy who has blocked us and it is sometimes, but sometimes it's God. The virus has stopped us from doing many things, but we are still able to congregate. Right now we are still under the protection of Almighty God. Those who trust in the Lord will not lack any good thing. Right now our faith is being tempered like iron in a furnace. Remember, 'You are tempted in the same way that everyone else is tempted. But God can be trusted not to let you be tempted too much, and he will show you how to escape from your temptations' (I Cor 10:13 CEV).

"This is a word for all of us today, 'Moses answered the people, "Fear not! Stand your ground, and you will see the victory the Lord will win for you today. The Egyptians whom you see today you will never see again'" (Ex 14:13 NAB). Those in power that seek to destroy the people of God are watching. Various Israelis said different things, according to Rabbi Yonatan Ben-Uzzio. He said that even though they were all Israelites, there were many factions. There were many ways to address the situation, but Moshe (Moses) addressed the whole nation because, if they broke into groups and did different things, it would be a disaster. Moses called them to be reunited and stand together, not in multiple factions. It is the same with us now. The battle is not ours, but God's.



### Some have suggested alternate routes

The trap was not a trap for the Israelis, but a trap for the Egyptians. This situation in America is the same. It can be rendered over for the good.

Our God has set traps for the evil people in America. Let us not rejoice over their destruction, but pray for their repentance.

“God parted the water for them. This is a sign for every one of us to stand and be united in that love. In this unity, we will testify to the world and even to those who come against us.

“What is happening is happening in succession. It seems we are truly in the last days. The word is being given to Christian leaders: it is imperative we do this **together in unity**.

“God told me something back in June of 2020, when we were looking for a house in the middle of Covid, which made it really difficult. In early June we were praying and I was given a vision like a dream. I heard the voice of a young man. He was speaking of military covenants. He spoke calmly and peacefully, but I was told to deliver the message immediately. He spoke like a radio/television news caster and he was speaking to a number of different people – again, I only heard his voice. He was giving a whole standardized message with snippets of commands to individuals. I asked God what it meant and he responded to me in that same young man’s voice. I thought it was an angel. Then I saw maps of Georgia. The voice was a military man, probably a general. The presentation was addressed to many places, but all I saw was North Georgia.


“The Lord said, ‘This is the blockade to be established. The blocks are all leaders, whether they realize they are leaders or not.’

**General examples:** superstitions, horoscopes, abuse of prescribed medicines (Greek for sorcery is Pharmakeia), illegal drugs and even threats of physical harm or extortion (blackmail) could be considered witchcraft. Also included would be manipulation through intimidation, lies or condemnation or domination. It is all about control or power over a person or people. "Rev 2:5 says, 'I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent' (ESV). Many churches have had their lampstands removed and taken somewhere else. They are still closed. We have been in shallow water for so long that we no longer remember how to swim.

'and if the Spirit of the one who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who indwells you' (Rom 8:11 LSMV). In the early church there was no such thing as children's church. The children sat with their parents. The concept of a youth minister never came about until the 1930s."

"Mat 25:40 says, 'Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done it unto me' (KJV). When you give to those like the ones in prison who cannot give back, you are giving to the least of these."

"There is witchcraft in some churches now because there has been no encounter with God. Somebody may say the right words, pray the right prayer, but they are not saved yet because there has been no encounter. Nothing in the Bible tells us to have people 'repeat after me.' The 'Sinner's Prayer' came in the 1950s when people were trying to increase their congregations. We have sold God short. He wants to meet with us, but the phone, the clock..."

"In my quest to find out about Covid, the Lord brought me to Genesis chapter six. In this chapter we see, 'when men began to multiply on Earth, and daughters were born to them, the sons of God saw that the daughters of men were attractive; and they took wives for themselves, whomever (as many as NAB) they chose (Gen 6:1-2 CJB).

**(BFN note:** the book of Enoch is not part of the Bible we read, therefore, many do not choose to find it credible. It is, however, referred to by biblical characters, including some in the New Testament. The book of Enoch was lost for many centuries until a Scottish explorer found it in Ethiopia and translated it into English in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. This subject in Gen 6 is treated in much more detail in Enoch ch 6-15, even to naming those guilty angels, the specific things they did that angered God and their punishment. It sheds some light on this subject. It can most likely be found in a book store or on the internet. If anyone is interested enough, BFN has the entire 107 chapters on file.)



Ms Sharon Bryan of Living Hope Christian Fellowship spoke briefly.

"Hebrews tells us, 'And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another, and all the more as you see the day approaching' (Heb 10:24-25 NIV). Be praying for people who are falling away, especially those because of

Corona. The Lord said, ‘This is my command: that you keep on loving each other Just as I have loved you’ (John 15:12 JNT). “The sequoia tree has shallow roots, but is still 250-300 feet tall. The reason they remain standing strong is not because of the individual roots; it is because they grow in groves. They stand together and support each other. Sometimes our roots aren’t so deep either. We need to support one another.”

“The angels had sons with the daughters of men: ‘after the sons of Heaven had intercourse with the daughters of men’ Gen 6:4 NAB), ‘the N’filim (Nephilim) were on the earth’ (Gen 6:4 CJB). The book of Enoch talks about the evil done by these giants before the flood. These giants, the Nephilim, were genetically changed to be what they were. Even after the flood, their genes remained, possibly through the wives of the sons of Noah (Noah). We know this because there is mention of them in later Bible books. In Num 13:33 the spies reported, ‘and there we saw the sons of Anak’ [Anakim, giants as the N’Filim] (KJV). In Deut 2:10 Moses, speaking of the wilderness of Moab said, ‘The Emim had dwelt there... ..as tall as the Anakim’ [Nephilim] (NKJV). These giants were modified through sorcery.

“Today we face a killer so small you can only see it through an electron microscope. Today’s sorcerers wear lab coats. The truth has come out that Covid was engineered in the United States, sent to China and is still being funded by the sorcerers scientists in the US. Sorcery is an old world term. We’re talking about objects that have been modified for a specific outcome (see above).

“We are the ones chosen to deal with this, not the victims of it. Will we run and hide or rise up like the word of God says? Let us remember, ‘Whether God saves me or not, I’m still not gonna bow down to your idols.’ The word says, ‘and they have conquered him by the blood of the lamb and by the word of their testimony, for they loved not their lives even unto death’ (Rev 12:11 ESV). This is **not** our home and I will **not** live in fear. We can go after this thing individually – every one by himself, every church body by itself, every denomination by itself, but that is absolutely not what God intended and everyone of you knows that. If we tackle this problem **together**, we will actually **be** effective.

**Those who stand with the WBCA don't make the mistake of believing that to be in unity, we must never disagree on anything. You do not see that even in nuclear families.** Nor do we make the mistake of thinking we must all believe exactly the same thing. That will never happen.

We believe that there are **eight principles** that must be considered when establishing sound doctrine and criterion for unity. There may be a few more, but definitely not less nor significantly more, other wise we border on works of the law, rather than works of faith. They are:

1: Humans are born with a sin nature; all have sinned and without Christ, are worthy of Hell, not fit for Heaven.

2: Yeshua (Jesus) is the messiah, the spotless Lamb of God, and in fact, is God himself, the second member of the Godhead, not a second God: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

3: Christ the Messiah was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of a virgin (Miriam also called Mary) and sinless.

4: Jesus (Yeshua) died on the cross for your sins and mine.

5: Almighty God the Father raised Messiah (Christ) from the dead on the third day.

6: Christ will return for his bride at the appointed time of the Father.

7: The Holy Bible is completely trustworthy, for it is inspired by the Holy Spirit.

8: Blatant sin (living in sin) is intolerable and the Community of Messiah (Church) must not tolerate it from its own.

### Wisdom missed (from pg 5)

He asked me for a Bible. We are intimidating to many baby Christians because we read the word, study it and know it. He knew I went to church a lot, but he has never attended a revival. His little brother Bryce knows you all, but Ty has no idea what a revival is.

"I told him he needed to be kingdom-minded. He told me that on Christmas Eve he dropped to his knees in the shower and told the Lord, 'I can't do it on my own.'

"He started asking about all the different churches. He thought there were about 20 in the whole area. I told him there were hundreds and that there were 57 just in the WBCA. Just like him, there are countless people living in ignorance out there. I explained to him about the Whole Body of Christ Alliance, what we do and what we are trying to do. I told him that in bringing the denominations and factions together, it shows that the differences mean nothing to Jesus. He asked me, 'why have I never heard this in church?'

"It is so important that we keep doing what we're doing. I would never have been able to explain it to my son had I not been with the WBCA.

"Pastors, please try to make it clear to your people how important this is, especially now with all this political upheaval. Millenials think it's always been like this because they have not lived long enough to know much of anything."



**Herman Parks the Bible teacher from  
Alternative View**

"We say, 'I love my mother,'" Herman Parks the Bible teacher told the people at Living Hope, "but we also say 'I love hot dogs, I love athletic activities, trees, grass, objects.' Some people are even 'in love' with the concept of being 'in love.' We use the word to explain behaviors. 'I did it because I love her.' A man in an adulterous relationship may call it love, while the preacher calls it sin. "Agape is **not** an

emotion; it is an action, a behavior. We don't agape **because**; we agape **in spite of**. Agape is unconditional; phileo is not. You don't love your best bud except upon condition.

"In Greek, the language in which the New Testament was written, there are at least five words for love (Actually there at least seven: agapao, agape', philautos, philotheos, philos [or phileo] and eros). In John 21:15-17 we see, 'Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love [agape] me more than these?" He [Peter] said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love [phileo] you." He [Jesus] said to him, "Feed my lambs." He [Yeshua] said to him [Peter] a second time, "Simon Son of John, do you love [agape] me?" He [Peter] said to him, "Yes, Lord; you know that I love [phileo] you." He [Yeshua] said to him, "Tend my sheep." He [Yeshua] said to him the third time, "Simon son of John, do you love [agape] me?" Peter was grieved because he [Jesus] said to him the third time, "Do you love me?" and he [Peter] said to him, "Lord, you know everything: you know that I love [phileo] you." Jesus said to him [Peter], "Feed my sheep" (ESV).

"C. S. Lewis calls agape selfless, unconditional love. Jesus is asking Peter, 'Do you have love for others because of me?' He is asking if Peter has the kind of love that is not dependant upon feelings' It is not without feelings, but in spite of feelings.

"Jesus went on in John 21:18 to tell Peter that he would die because of his love for the flock. "Mat 5:46 says, 'If you love only those people who love you, will God reward you for that? Even tax collectors love their friends' (CEV). In cases like this, the test of real love is: will you keep God's commands regardless of how you feel? We tend to actually become what we pretend to be. Your feelings and behavior may be a contradiction because agape love is tested by loving those who hate you.

"By this we see that you cannot **love** an object – your car, pizza etc. Love is **not** an extreme form of 'like;' that is called cathexis. It is possible to cathect your car, cathect pizza, or cathect baseball. Yeshua said, 'A new command I give you: Love one another. **As I have loved you**, so you must love one another' (John 13:34 NIV).

"He loved us when we did **not** love him. With this we can work for the real unity in the body that we give lip service to. Without this, it is only lip service."



**Jamie Stroup, wife of David Stroup, chief of staff of Secretary of Outreach**

"Mat 4:19 says, 'Come after me and I will make you fishers of men' (JNT). Ms Jamie Stroup addressed the WBCA at Living Hope Christian Fellowship in January at the 7-day revival.

"The WBCA has been going for over ten years," Jamie continued, "and there are 57 churches in the alliance. Outreach is something we are **all** commanded to do in Mat 28, Mark 16 and other places. We must reach out to those who are not saved and keep reaching out to them until we can get them into a church somewhere. In addition to this, however, we must reach out to other churches if the alliance is to remain for

another ten years.

"The amount of division in the world, in this country and even in the church is appalling and seems to be growing worse. Those of us in the body of Christ are supposed to be unified, not separated by doctrinal issues and a hundred other things, some unbelievably petty.

"We meet once every quarter and **speak** about unity in the body, but how many of us actually get up from in front of the TV and work for it as the Lord tells us? We have passed around a sheet and people have put there names and numbers on it to do outreach, but then, when the outreach team calls, too many of those people have reasons why they cannot help. Brothers, this has to change. We have some people that signed up who are following through, but we need people willing to reach out to the lost, to reach out to other church bodies. 
“For he is like a refiner’s fire and like a launderer’s soap. He will sit as a refiner and a purifier of silver.”

A refiner sits before a blazing fire with a pot of molten metal over it. The fire is kept hot by the pumping of the bellows. He looks into the pot and studies the liquid silver. While doing this, he is refining it to its purest form. He looks at it intently, watching for the perfect time, the time when all the dross (a scum formed on the surface of molten metal) settles to the bottom of the pot and he can see his reflection in the refined silver. At just the right instant he has to draw the pot out of the fire, knowing that further heat will be ruinous. Therefore, he has accomplished what he wanted. The Lord is our refiner and wants to do the same thing with us. He sees dross in our lives, so he places us over the fire of trial and hardship. He knows just how much heat it will take to remove the impurities in us. The instant that he sees his likeness reflected in our lives, he turns off the heat, lest he ruin us by allowing temptations above what we are able to bear overcome us (I Cor 10:13).

In the midst of intense heat, we are tempted to complain that it is too much. But we fail to remember that our master is in the heat with us, constantly looking for his reflection.

The apostle Paul could actually “take pleasure” in these testings. “Therefore, I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in needs, in persecutions, in distresses, for Christ’s sake. For when I am weak, then I am strong (II Cor 12:10). The literal meaning is that he thought well of the infirmities, reproaches, necessities, persecutions, and distresses that he endured. Therefore, I ask myself and continually seek to come to the place where I allow God to work in my life without any reservations. When I do, he will show his strength in my weakness, and his reflection will be clearly visible in me.

I usually place any short commentary I have in the Bible Knowledge article with the question. I refrained from doing that in the May 2021 issue because there was no room. I believe, however, that this particular commentary is important enough to include in the June 2021 issue.

The first original question was in March and was question #3: “What church suffered because of the ‘synagogue of Satan?’

The answer given in May was, ‘The church that suffered from the “synagogue of Satan” was the church at Smyrna (Rev 2:8-11).’

There is, however, a modern day synagogue of Satan. It is Hollywood, not the town necessarily, but the film industry, which is mostly controlled by those who claim to be Jews. They are not Jews; they are atheists, who use Judaism as an excuse to ignore, down play, and work against Messiah and portray his people in the most negative light that they can. 
The second original question was also in March and was question #4: “Name a church that received letters from Paul the apostle and (we assume) from the apostle John.”

The answer given was the church at Ephesus. This is an assumption because John was in his later years and was already exiled to the island of Patmos. There is no actual record of his death and he was only on the Island for just under two years. The Lord did tell Peter, “If it is my will that he remain until I come, what is that to you? You follow me” (John 21:22 ESV).

We also know as a matter of history that Polycarp was John the apostle’s second when he was Pastor of the Church at Ephesus. When John was arrested by Roman emperor Domitian to be boiled in oil, Polycarp became bishop of the church and was martyred in AD 156 because he refused to call Caesar “Lord.”




## Mozelle

## On Prayer (Why Pray?)

If I love someone, I want to spend time with them. How can I say that I love my children or my husband if I hardly ever spend time with them? How can I say that I love the Lord if I hardly ever spend time with him? If the only time I ever pray is when I'm in church or in trouble, I don't even **have** much of a relationship with God. Statistically, where do most "Christians" do most of their praying? The answer is: in church. I want to know Jesus and, more importantly, I want him to know me. When Jesus stated that not everyone who called him "Lord, Lord" would enter the kingdom of heaven, He said he would say to them, "I never knew you. Depart from me you workers of iniquity." (Mat 7:21-23)



Do you like to pray? Do you enjoy your prayer time, or do you find it dull and boring? Do you believe that things happen because you pray, or do you just go through the motions because you are supposed to? We need to ask ourselves questions like these if we are going to learn to take prayer seriously.

Prayer should be enjoyable and it should be effective if we are going to be devoted to prayer as the believers in the first century were. This is why some pointers on prayer are needed to inspire people to pray more confidently and fervently. The purpose of this series of articles is to create a desire to reach out and touch the heart of God. The purpose is not to merely teach people about prayer, but to generate prayer. It is

much more important, rather than have people simply learn about prayer, to have them actually pray.

There are 3 statements of faith about prayer that, when things are understood, will inspire people to believe and will help prayer become a vital and also an enjoyable part of Christian life.

1: **Things will be different because I pray.** If you pray for your spouse, your children, your best friend, or you parents, things will be different than they would've been. I mean that – things **will** be different. Because I prayed for my daughter this morning, I know that her day will be different than it would have been. I prayed for the United States of America last night, and I know that things will be different in the U.S. because I prayed. Prayer has an effect. It is more than worthwhile.

2: **The throne of grace is wide open to me.**

This is so very important. The throne of grace is open – wide open – to you, and anything on God's heart is available to **you** if you pray. Prayer is centered around the throne of grace.

3: **Nothing is born without conception.** Conception doesn't just happen. In the natural world, there must be a physical union. The same thing is true with the spiritual realm. There must be union for conception and there must be conception for anything to be birthed. This is true for puppies, calves, babies, or answers to prayer. Answers to prayer do not just happen. Prayer is not hit-or-miss. There must be union with God. God operates on the basis of principles found in scripture. If we line up with what is on God's heart and what is in God's scripture, our spirit is put in union with his spirit, and conception takes place. Only when conception takes place is an answer to prayer born.

Do these statements inspire more faith in you? They inspire me and make me more eager to pray because I know they are true.

Let's take a look now at James 5:16, "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much." What James is saying is: the earnest, continual, heartfelt, fervent prayer of a godly man or woman releases mighty power and effects. The word "fervent" in the KJV implies intensity and continuation. Therefore, I believe that the prayer James is talking about is earnest, continual, and heartfelt.

Notice that the second part of the verse says that the prayer of a godly person releases mighty power and effects. Something will happen when a godly person begins and continues to pray with all her heart. When we pray, mighty effects are released. Prayer causes things to happen in your marriage, your church, or your pastor's sermon.

When you pray, "My Lord, my God, speak to our pastor this Sunday. Anoint him, and flow through him. Give him a word of wisdom and a word of knowledge. Give him food for us, Father," your pastor will preach better. Things will be different on Sunday morning than they would have been because you prayed a continual, heartfelt, fervent prayer. That kind of prayer will release mighty miracles.

If you came to me with a problem, and I told you to pray about it, what would you think? You would probably think I had nothing to offer and just put you off with a cliché – "Pray about it." Somehow, when we hear the word, "prayer," we think boredom and ineffectiveness. Why do you think that is? It isn't God's fault. The forces of darkness try to discourage us from realizing

that the mighty power of prayer releases effects and miracles. That "ho hum, she told me to pray" feeling is from the enemy. The idea that prayer is a boring and ineffective task for times when nothing else can be said or done is completely false. James says that the effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails – **It accomplishes something!**

Do you like to pray? Prayer should be one of your greatest sources of enjoyment. Although prayer is work, it can be your most delightful labor and your most important occupation.

I Col 4:12-13 we see, "Epaphras, who is one of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always laboring fervently for you in prayers that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God. For I bear him record, that he hath a great zeal for you, and them that are in Laodicea, and them in Hierapolis."

Have you ever heard of Epaphras? He is nowhere near as well known as Paul, Apollos, or Timothy. But still, Epaphras is mentioned in holy scripture because he was an intercessor, and his chief delight was prayer. Paul mentioned his zeal because Epaphras prayed continually that believers would stand "perfect and complete in all the will of God."

You might say, "Well, I'm just a nobody. I just go to church. No one even knows who I am. I'm just one of the people in the next to the last row. I feel too inadequate." If you are an intercessor, you are one of the most important people in that congregation. Every pastor needs a whole crew praying for him and for his family, the church, the elder board. Every church needs several Epaphrases.

Devotion to prayer is loving to pray. Acts 1:14 says, "These all with one mind were continually devoting themselves to prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers."

The last mention of Mary the mother of Jesus in the Bible finds her praying. She was at a prayer meeting – **devoted** to prayer. These people "prayed in" the first Pentecost. There came "a sound... ..as of a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the whole house." (Acts 2:2)

Tongues of fire came and sat on their heads, and they were all "filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the spirit gave them utterance." (Acts 2:4)

Do you know why we don't have more fullness in the Holy Spirit? We do not have people devoted to prayer. It is important to note that it was a prayer meeting that established the first Pentecost. When we pray we prepare ourselves for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit.

Also in Acts 2:42 we see, "And they were continually devoting themselves to the apostle's teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer."

This is immediately following the Pentecostal sermon. In fact, Acts 2:41 says that 3000 people were born again and baptized in water. This early church established itself in 4 areas. The members devoted themselves to:

- 1: The apostle's doctrine (the New Testament)
- 2:Fellowship – so very important and something the church today often overlooks.
- 3: The breaking of bread – either communion or eating with each other house to house.
- 4: and Prayer

The early church was based upon, among other things, a devotion to prayer. Prayer was a delight. Acts 4:23-24, 31 describes what happened at one of those Prayer meetings. "And

when they had been released, they went to their own companions, and reported all that the chief priests and the elders had said to them. And when they heard this, they lifted their voices to God with one accord... ..And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak the word of God with boldness."

Sometimes we want the power of God but without seeking **Him**. The book of Acts says that the place where the disciples were gathered was shaken. They prayed with such zeal and power that they could actually feel the building shake. It was not an earthquake. It was the power of God. The Bible says they were filled with the Holy Ghost. They had all been baptized with the Holy Ghost once, but now they were filled **again**.

One of our problems is that we do not get on our faces before God to get refilled. Prayer leads to being refilled. After these believers were refilled, they went out and spoke the word of God with boldness. We will not have the power, the miracles, the boldness or the souls saved unless we first pray.

Those in the early church were devoted to prayer and every time they prayed the spirit moved. Their prayers were continual, heartfelt, and fervent prayers that released mighty effects and power. Ours can be the same.


I've read Volume one and volume two of *keep on Truckin'* and it's like reading Rock's diary. I recommend you get a copy.




